[REPUBLIC ACT No. 10072]

AN ACT RECOGNIZING THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL RED CROSS AS AN INDEPENDENT, AUTONOMOUS, NONGOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATION AUXILIARY TO THE AUTHORITIES OF THE REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES IN THE HUMANITARIAN FIELD, TO BE KNOWN AS THE PHILIPPINE RED CROSS

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Short Title. - This Act shall be known as the "Philippine Red Cross Act of 2009".

SEC. 2. Declaration of Principles and State Policies. Pursuant to Article II, Section 2 of the Constitution which
provides for the adoption of the generally accepted principles
of international law as part of the law of the land, the State
shall at all times act in conformity with the Geneva
Conventions of 1949 and their additional protocols, and the

Be it enocted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Title. - This Act shall be known as the "Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010".
