How to use your inhaler with a Spacer/Chamber Mouth Piece

Steps: Take your inhaler while you are standing.

- 1. Shake the inhaler for 5 seconds
- 2. Remove the cap from the inhaler and spacer
- 3. Attach the inhaler mouthpiece to the open end of the spacer
- 4. Blow all your air out
- 5. Place your lips snugly around the mouthpiece
- **6.** Give the inhaler 1 push to get the medicine into the chamber
- **7.** Breathe in slowly over 3-4 seconds. Hold your breath for a count of 10 seconds. (If you hear the whistle sound, you breathed in too quickly.)
- 8. Wait at least 1 minute between each puff and repeat
- **9.** Always swish and spit or brush your teeth after using your controller medication.



Cleaning:

Wash the mask and chamber once a week in clear dish soap, rinse well and air dry.
