



BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 2018

Our three-year program focuses on the dynamics of the spiritual direction conversation in the tradition of St. Ignatius Loyola's *Spiritual Exercises*. A spiritual director in training will learn how to help a person listen contemplatively to God's movement in his or her life.

We will present the foundational principles in Ignatian Spirituality and Christian decision-making. Theory and practice will combine to develop skills in fostering intimacy with God and discernment of God's presence and action, both in your life and in the lives of those whom you assist.

YEAR I

Classes will meet twice per month and will focus on teaching the theory of spiritual direction, as well as interactive training in listening and responding skills. Participants will begin a Spiritual Direction Practicum with individual supervision after the first of the year.

YEAR 2

Classes will meet twice per month. Course work will focus on a thorough study of the text and dynamics of the *Spiritual Exercises* of St. Ignatius Loyola. Participants will be asked to pray the *Spiritual Exercises* over a period of nine months and to continue the Spiritual Direction Practicum begun in Year One. Individual and group supervision will be provided.

(Year 2 Tuition - \$1,000)

OPTIONAL YEAR 3

Classes will meet once per month, and will highlight further theory and practice of St. Ignatius' discernment of spirits in relation to specific issues in spiritual direction, e.g. aspects of women's spirituality, experiences of mourning and suffering, advanced degrees of prayer. Participants will have the opportunity to offer the Exercises to individuals and/or small groups. Individual and group supervision will be provided.

(Year 3 Tuition - \$1,000)
