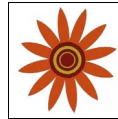

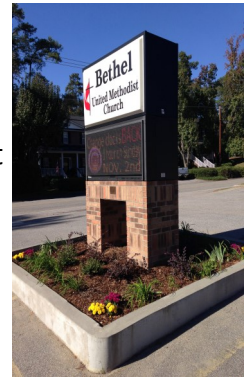
## Memorial Gardens Update

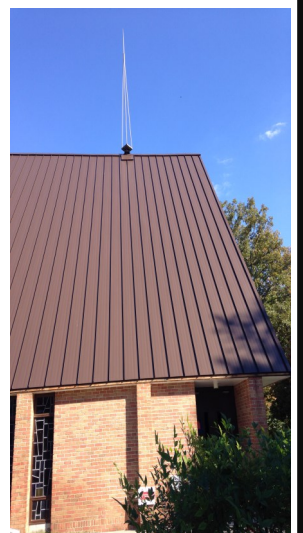
