Richland Creek Water Supply Program – December 7th 2016

Progress at the Water Treatment Plant!

Construction progress continues on the Richland Creek Reservoir Water Supply Program, with the first concrete pour taking place at the Water Treatment Plant on November 22, 2016. An excavator was used to carry about 8 cubic yards of concrete to the bottom of the gravity thickener excavation to pour the foundation for the center pier of the gravity thickener tank. Completing that center pier foundation clears the way for the floor of the 60-foot diameter tank to be constructed next, with the larger pours of the floor and walls to be completed using concrete pump trucks. As the first concrete pour on the Water Treatment Plant, the event was attended by Paulding County Post IV Commissioner Tony Crowe.





The Richland Creek Reservoir (RCR) is a new 305-acre reservoir that once completed, will supply up to three billion gallons of drinking water to existing and future populations in and around Paulding County.
