


Here's a sample of how the trades industry implements SMS

The Solution

When it comes to on-site communications the delivery of what you say must have a sense of urgency. It needs to be quick, memorable, and direct.

Let's look into the most common ways to communicate while on the job:

1) In-person / Radio / Phone


- Pros Immediate, effortless, and commands urgency
- Cons Can easily be misheard from outside noise or bad reception
 No immediate written record of what was said

2) Email

- **Pros** Communicate with multiple groups in different locations at once
 - Can search through an inbox to find specific project points
 - Good for creating a record for long format content
- Cons Does not provide a sense of urgency
 - Clutter can build quickly, and a data connection is needed


3) Text Messages

- Pros Provides a quick means for employees to report urgent matters
 - Control which groups see your message and whether or not they can reply, thus reducing clutter on more important tasks
 - Instant record of what was said (no data connection needed)
 - Works in remote areas with low reception
- Cons Mobile device needed




SMS Solutions

Ideally workers should be able to instantly refer back to what you said without going through a text heavy summary. That's why text messages are so effective for on-site communications. Here are three of the most efficient SMS solutions for the trades industry:



Group SMS

When an urgent matter comes up, any member of your team will be able to instantly inform everyone via text.



SMS Reminders

Send reminders to your team to keep them on top of their tasks. You can also track whether they have received your text with a confirmation.

SMS Alerts
