# Academic Calendar for the Fall 2020 and Spring 2021 Terms

#### **Credit Hour Definition Policies**

East Carolina University (ECU) policy follows the federal definition of a credit hour, the SACSCOC credit hour policy, and <u>UNC-SO Policy 400.1.6</u>, which requires that all UNC system campuses schedule a minimum of 750 minutes of instructional time per credit hour. <u>ECU REG02.07.01</u> requires a minimum of 2,250 minutes of instructional activity for a three-credit, hour lecture class. As a matter of practice, campuses generally schedule classes that exceed this minimum number of contact minutes. A brief review of course scheduling across our campuses revealed slight variances in minimum contact minutes in excess of 2,000 minutes and whether the 120-minute final exam is included in the minimum contact minutes. Campuses should conduct a review to ensure their modified schedules are in compliance with university policy. At a minimum, a clause may be added to ECU's Credit Hour Definition Regulation that states, "during a state of emergency, the closing of a campus, or other extraordinary circumstances for a prolonged period that affects an entire campus, the minimum number of contact minutes may be reduced to 2,250 minutes or the equivalent amount of instruction and studying that includes a final exam of no more than 120-minutes. In person instruction may be supplemented with online instruction and/or additional instruction beyond the scheduled class meetings."

Below is a matrix that represents the **minimum** number of contact minutes each week, based on the number of credit hours per class if not satisfied through another equivalent means.
