Morning Drop-Off



Please remember that it is very important that the children get out of the car on the right side. We understand that there are car seats and broken doors, but cars are continuously driving in the left lane around the loop and we do not want any children hurt! **DO NOT LET YOUR CHILDREN OUT BEFORE THE SIGN/YELLOW STRIP.** Also, please stay in your car. The drop off volunteers will assist your children with any needs they may have. This includes pulling those big instruments from the trunk or rear seats. It is important that we keep the traffic moving and the children safe. There is parking available if you want to get out of the car or find it impossible to shift seats around to accommodate right side exiting. We care about the safety of the children and need for these rules to be followed.
