The Cambridge Redevelopment Authority (CRA) is hosting a public forum to discuss a proposed amendment to the Kendall Square Urban Renewal Plan (KSURP), following the recommendations of the K2 Planning Study, completed by the City of Cambridge in December 2013.

We invite community members to participate in a presentation and discussion of the potential next phase of commercial and housing development within the MXD portion of the Plan Area (see reference map on coUrbanize). Attendees will participate in an activity to help prioritize public benefits related to the development.

You don't have to wait until March 12 to get involved! Visit the CRA's KSURP coUrbanize site to contribute to the ongoing conversation.

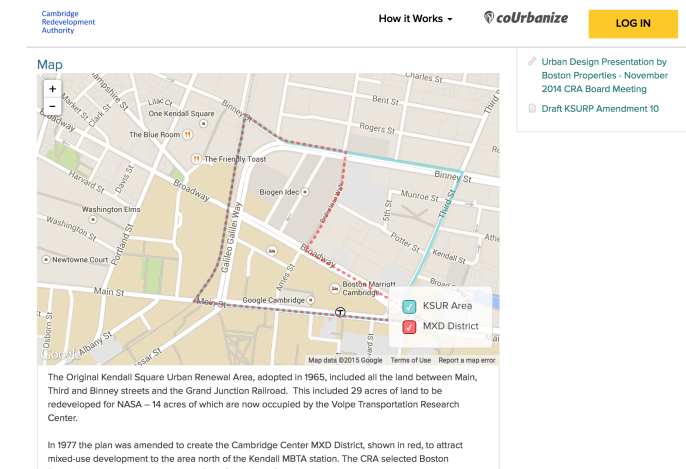

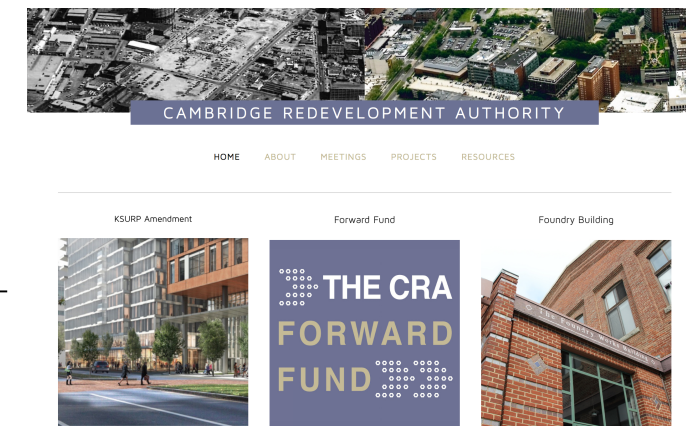
