

Around the Region Bob Saville, President

So....did you get your registration in for Parade? I know, I know...there was a bit of a glitch on the website. But did you persevere and mail it in, or wait until the following day to get online? As I write this, everyone who submitted their registration will be accepted, and there are a few, limited spaces left. Plus, there is typically about a 5% cancellation rate, so if you are still thinking about attending, please sign up. Even if you end up on the waitlist, there is a good chance you will get in anyway. Oh, and to all those who have asked questions about what a non-registrant can attend? Basically the same thing as anyone wandering around downtown Charlotte: you'll only be able to view the concours on the city streets. You will not be allowed to attend the banquets, tours, goodie store, tech sessions, and most of all....you will not be able to enter the Historic and Heritage (H&H) display at the Convention Center. The H&H will be possibly one of the most complete representations of Porsche's racing and street car history, with just about every model race car and street car on display. This is NOT something you want to miss, so get your registration in now.

About 2 years ago, I wrote an article about our Region's Sponsors, and I thought it was about time to rehash some of the topics I brought up then, since over the past 2 years, our region has grown a great deal, and many of you may not have even been members back then! You see their names listed on our events, see their logos on the give-aways such as shirts and bags, and sometimes get to meet individuals from the companies at that particular event. But the question many of you ask is....what do they REALLY do for us?

Well, the answer is simple: They provide money and/or products that help subsidize the events, allowing us to charge the registrants a lower price to attend. In return, they get some visibility to a fairly large and focused group of individuals (all of you) who they hope will patronize their business when the need arises. These companies and/or individuals feel that we, as a group, are important enough to their business to spend their money on us, so we in turn should use them when we need to buy products and services.

Through the years, the dynamics of sponsorship have changed dramatically. More and more small companies are getting into the act, offering up their hard earned dollars to gain some visibility to our members. Some throw in a few hundred dollars to help us offset the price of things like trophies, shirts, and refreshments. Others step up big and become a "title" sponsor, offering much larger sums of funding and products to help our events become really top notch.

Without minimizing the gracious offerings of some of our smaller sponsors, I would like to highlight two companies that have continued to go above and beyond everyone else: **Porsche of Hickory** and **Speedwerks.**

For those of you who have attended any of our events in 2007, you know that **Porsche of Hickory** has contributed a great deal to our region. Appropriately, they have consistently sponsored our largest and most costly event of the year, our PCA Club Race. Running such a large event requires lots of volunteers, lots of resources, and an awful lot of money. Speedwerks steps up each year and offers whatever they can to help pull off this huge endeavor as smoothly as possible. They also open up their facility for a great Swap Meet each year (It'll be in August, 2008), providing food and drink for all.

Mountain Area Report Doug McKee, Area Director


Greetings.... It's spring.


