Porsche High-Performance Driving Handbook, 2nd Edition By Vic Elford

Retail: \$29.95 in paperback with 39 color and 55 b/w photos

As one might expect from Vic Elford, this book informs the reader how to drive a Porsche to its limit. He starts with the basics of adjusting the car to provide optimal comfort and control, continues with how to maintain balance by driving smoothly, covers suspension and drive train

components and their function, (both vintage and new technology), tells how to maintain balance during acceleration, cornering and braking, and wraps up with accident avoidance and driving in unusual conditions.

He gets down in the weeds with heel-toe gear shifts, the anatomy of a corner and dynamics of cornering, and various types of braking. All this is punctuated with personal experiences, examples, drawings and many photos of Porsches being driven well.

For those who want to really understand the components and art of high performance driving, in my opinion this is a "must read."
