




We held our Fall DE at Carolina Motorsports Park over September 11th and 12th. 98 drivers attended the event on the 2 & 1/4 mile, 14 turn track in Kershaw, SC. Linda and Clark from Apex Performance were there once again in support of the event. We have really enjoyed their support of the DE program this year. A few mechanical issues like blown head gaskets, blown transmissions or a bent control arm could prevent everyone from enjoying the weekend, if not for Apex. Well, at least til Monday. Shane Tisdale was shaking down the Key Lime Jetta which he and his team will campaign in the September LeMons race at CMP to benefit Shiners Hospital. The Jetta was quite complete; I understand it will race with a full Fez. And from the crowd at the goodie store on Saturday evening, I wasn't sure if I was in the Sand Hills of South Carolina or Napa Valley when Sadie broke out the wine and cheese. I wonder if that helped her sales?

**Upcoming 1)** Registration is open for the Drivers Ed event being held in conjunction with the PCA Club Race at CMP on October 30 & 31. This will be a single DE group scheduled around the race activities. The DE group typically gets loads of track time over the weekend. Plus you get to hang out with the Cup cars and the big haulers. It's a great atmosphere to start with and if you add a bit of Halloween fun, there's no telling the ghosts and ghouls that might be at the track.

**Upcoming 2)** Registration is also open for our return to VIR Full course on November 19-21. This is always a great event to cap off the DE activities for the year. Once again, our regular format event will be held Saturday/Sunday with Friday being a solo only day. Registration is online and is \$285 for PCA members, \$350 for nonmembers. We had 40 register on the first day alone!

Change in helmet requirements for **2011** - I'm shopping for a new helmet or perhaps I'll find one under the Christmas tree, but everyone should be aware of the upcoming changes to the helmet requirements. There are no changes for the remaining 2010 events. beginning with our 2011 events, we will no longer accept SA2000 helmets. PCA requires helmets meet either the current standard or one previous version. Snell just released their 2010 SA helmet standard which now outdates the SA2000 certification for PCA DE events. There are significant updates to the SA2010 standard and manufacturers are beginning to ramp up production. For those who have to replace a SA2000 helmet, SA2010 helmets should be widely available around year's end. Unless there are significant issues with helmets coming to market, SA2000 and M2000 helmets will NOT be accepted for our Drivers Education events in 2011. SA2005 certified helmets will









continue to be accepted until 2015. Vendors may be offering closeout pricing on remaining SA2005 stock. If you are looking at helmets and will be purchasing soon, consider the lifespan of each standard.

Do not confuse the SA standard with the M2010 standard. M rated helmets are designed for motorcycles and are not accepted for Carolinas Region DE events.




### **50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Tour**


Gary Pennington's beautiful race shop and car collection in Columbia, South Carolina.






# LADY TAKES ALL. AGAIN!
