Dates for 2019 Board Meetings will be posted on the Region Calendar in Tobacco Roads and on the website.

The January meeting was a Planning Meeting for the region and all Event Chairs presented their budgets to the board for approval. Area Directors are still planning for their specific area but a listing of what has been planned to date is shown on the calendar. All Regional and Area events will be posted in Tobacco Roads and on the Web. The calendar is filling up quickly and constantly changing but there are many options, social and track, and all events (regional/area) are open to all members.

We would like to welcome Bob Kim as the new Area Director for the Triangle Area replacing Adam Morrison. Bob previously held this position and is excited to be back actively involved with the region. We want to thank Adam Morrison for his service to the Triangle area. Our new Treasurer, Jim Hess, has been very busy and "burning the midnight oil" getting ready for his new position. In addition to learning QuickBooks and policies/procedures, Jim had to work with event chairs to prepare budgets for the January 12 meeting. As if that wasn't enough, Jim purchased a new computer to handle QuickBooks. Of course, all the programs are different when you update your computer and this is an area that I could not assist with in any way. But we had a lot of fun while working hard to complete the transition. Jim quickly learned that the Treasuer's responsibilities are a lot more involved than writing checks. A big thank you to Jim for making the many trips from Mint Hill to Lexington during this transition period.

There are a lot of events and activities being planned. The Tri-Region Spring Tour scheduled for May 2-4 is sold out with a "wait" list. By the time you read this column, Sommerfest registration will be open. Sommerfest dates are May 24-26 and will be held in conjunction with the Sandhills Motoring Festival at Little River Resort located in the Pinehurst

area. The Sandhills Area is hosting this event and it is also expected to be a "Sell Out", so register early. Fall Tour is hosted by the Hickory Area and is scheduled for November 1-3 at The Ridges in Hiawassee, GA. This event has also been a sell-out during the past couple of years. Track type events that are scheduled include five AutoX events and three DE events - see calendar for specific dates. Joint area events include a February 23 Tech Session hosted by the Sandhills/Triad Area. Hickory and Triad areas are hosting a joint Picnic on May 18. For details refer to the Calendar and/or Area Write-ups. The Carolinas Region Goodie Store will be set up at all three DE Events, Sommerfest and at Fall Tour. But there is no need to wait until an event to make a purchase. The Goodie Store Ad is on the back cover of TR and Kathy is always willing to help you with special or stock orders. There are many other area events in the planning stages so whether you prefer social or track, there are plenty of options. Get the Porsche out and participate, make new friends and reconnect with old friends!

One of the duties of the President is to send out information and notification emails to all members of the Carolinas Region. These are known as "Email Blasts." The email list comes from PCA National and is handled through a program accessed from the PCA National Website. After the email blast is sent, the President receives a report outlining the number of emails sent, the number that delivered and the number of emails rejected for incorrect email addresses. For example, the report from my last email blast stated that 2,993 emails were sent, but 832 (28%) were rejected due to incorrect email addresses or no email address. This presents a big problem when we are trying to notify you so please go to the PCA National Website and confirm that your correct email address is listed. This should be done for primary and family/associate members. The same is true with addresses. Please make sure that your address listed is correct. Thank you in advance for taking the time to check and update personal information on the PCA website.

Comments and suggestions for improvements to better serve the membership are always welcome. I look forward to visiting with you around the Region.





Driver Education:

Winter DE Seminar Report & Spring DE Update by John Babinski





On Sunday, January 20, 2019, the Drivers Education Team hosted the annual Winter DE Seminar at Carolina Motorsports Park. We had a full house in the CMP drivers lounge for our classroom session which started under windy and cloudy skies. But by the time the classroom discussion was completed the sun had come out making for perfect conditions for those hoped for parade laps. Our turnout was so large this year we had to split the attendees into 2 groups for the on track experience. That provided participants an opportunity to take their cars on track for a couple of slow speed parade laps to understand the geometry and geography of the CMP track layout. Thanks to all those members who took advantage of this opportunity and also to those instructors who came out to lend their experience and expertise. It kept those attending attentive and curious with plenty of good questions.

The ultimate purpose of the Winter DE Seminar is to help educate PCA members about our DE program. By learning about the DE program in depth...its purpose, the schedule, and the requirements, it gives a base of knowledge that can reduce the stress often associated with trying a new activity. Oftentimes, there's a misconception that the DE program is all about a bunch of souped up cars racing around a track almost uncontrollably at 10/10th's. This falsehood can be daunting for someone new to the sport and is actually far from the truth or the objectives of our program. The underlying objective in everything we do is to have a safe, fun and educational event while working to:

- Improve driving skills
- Acquire an understanding of vehicle dynamics
- Become better drivers
- Have fun and socialize with like-minded members

While many addicted long term DE'ers may begin to modify and upgrade their cars to enhance performance, for the beginning student any basic street car in street car configuration is welcome and actually encouraged. If it can pass a vehicle tech inspection it is welcome on the track. For most street cars that typically means just making sure you have refreshed brake fluid, good brake pads and newer tires with decent tread. The tech inspection by your mechanic will check a variety of other systems as required for your safety, but the brakes and tires get a bit harder workout on track than on the street and must be in good order. As a student you will have one of our PCA National Instructors in the car with you all weekend helping to guide you safely around the track. You drive at a speed where YOU are comfortable. During your first few weekends of doing DE's, learning and understanding track basics such as "the line", passing protocol and track terminology are the focus. Increased speed comes at an individual rate based on YOUR comfort level and skills improvement. Along with your in-car Instructor, instruction is also provided in a series of classroom sessions throughout the weekend held in between the on track sessions. These classroom sessions reinforce and add to the knowledge being shared by your in-car instructor. We run 4 or 5 run groups at our events which insures that you are only on track with other drivers of similar experience and skills. Beginners are all on track at the same time and every car has a student and an instructor providing extra eyes on the activity and insuring a safe experience for all.




