

One item of discussion at both meetings concerned Region Bylaws. Each Region is separately incorporated with the region creating their specific bylaws to be reviewed and endorsed by National. The discussions included the importance of having current bylaws to ensure they remain consistent with common practices and operations and are in consonance with the National Bylaws. Carolinas Region Bylaws were updated in 2015. National recommends that Bylaws be updated every 5 years so we will need to start reviewing our Bylaws in 2020.

One of the things the Triad Area does at their monthly meeting is to celebrate birthdays. If you are in attendance at the meeting and your birthday is during that month, the group sings Happy Birthday and you are treated to a desert of your choice from the menu. This is really a big deal in the Triad Area and my birthday is in August so I was treated to a free desert. At the 2019 Porsche Parade in Boca Raton, FL the Carolinas Region won Honorable Mention in PCA Public Service award division. This award comes with a cash prize for the Region.
