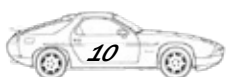
DONATION PRESENTATION

Member Randy Fritz has recently returned from a business trip to

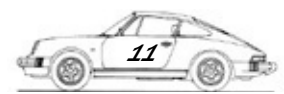
