


**UPCOMING TRIAD AREA EVENTS:**


- Based on age alone, many of our Members especially those who have attended this
  event in the past are considered higher risk for severe illness from the virus. As such,
  they are advised to avoid group activities, especially those held indoors.
- Prospective participants want to "wait and see" what the situation is like closer to the
  event before making a commitment. Venue management, on the other hand, needs a
  firm commitment now in order to hold the space for us.
- Though characterized as a "tour", this is primarily a social event. The venue has been
  chosen in large part because it is conducive to the social interactions our Members
  value. Unfortunately, these same characteristics make it extremely difficult to "social
  distance". For instance, it will be very difficult, if not impossible, to effectively practice
  "social distancing" during group meals.
- Federal, State and local jurisdictions continue to revise their guidelines as to how best to respond to the pandemic. The uncertainty as to what these guidelines may look like later in the year make it virtually impossible to formulate concrete longer-term plans.
- Nearly all Members asked have expressed a reluctance to participate until there is a
  vaccine to prevent contraction of the illness or until effective treatments exist neither
  of which are likely by November.

So ... though we feel it prudent to cancel this year's Fall Tour, we do hope you will plan to join us in 2021. Be sure to put November 5-7 on your calendar.




