

Hi Folks: First of all, I hope that everyone enjoyed the Holidays and are staying safe and warm as we move into 2021. Second, for those of you that might not have gotten the word, the Triad Area's January 19th monthly meeting previously scheduled to be held at Kick Back Jacks in Greensboro has been cancelled due to continued safety and health concerns related to COVID 19. I will keep you posted as we move into the beginning of 2021 as to the schedule for future monthly meetings and other planned events and activities.

Unfortunately 2020 has been a very bad year for Triad Area PCA planned events. At the beginning of 2020 the Triad Area had planned and scheduled eight events to be hosted throughout the year. However, we were only able to host two of them; the Tech Session at Porsche Greensboro in February (which took place long before the COVID 19 group meeting restrictions) and the drive to "VIR for Laps and Lunch Event" hosted in August. It is our hope that we will be able to make definite plans for meetings and events once the State mandates and group gathering restrictions are lifted and our members feel comfortable when attending.

2020 TRIAD AREA CHARITY DONATION STATUS

Charity donations for 2020 were at an all-time low for the Triad Area... Basically all of our regular charity fund raising events were cancelled (Roads and Rails Charity Drive; Porsche Corral at the American Children's Home Car Show; Oktoberfest; and the Christmas Party). In addition the Triad Area's 50/50 charity split the pot fund was significantly reduced due to the fact that we only held 6 regular meetings. However, with all of the above bad news, with support from the Carolinas Region Board of Directors and donations from Triad Area members, including 50/50 split the pot funds, the Triad Area donated a total of \$4,690.00 to local charities. Below is a summary of the Triad Area's 2020 Charity donations:

1. May, 2020 - \$1,000.00 - Greensboro Urban Ministries Food Bank

2. August, 2020 - \$307.00 - "Racing for Hero's (VIR Laps/ Lunch Event)

3. September, 2020 - \$1,083.00 - American Children's Home (Porsche Corral).

4. December, 2020 - \$1,000.00 - YMCA Camp Hanes in King, NC

5. December, 2020 - \$1,000.00 - American Children's Home Christmas Fund.

6. December, 2020 - \$300.00 - Salvation Army of Davidson County



I will continue to monitor the state and local Covid social guidelines for opportunities to get back together and meet as group for our dinner meetings and driving events.






