


Check presentation to Jess Hudson

My Porsche Adventure:

Just west of Canon City, Colorado, the spectacular Royal Gorge Bridge is 876' above the Colorado River.

Built as a tourist attraction, the bridge leads nowhere. Not for the faint hearted, those who trust the oak roadbed can walk over & back. I walked over for the first time in 1983 after rafting under the bridge. No cars are allowed.

There was a cog railway to descend from the top to the river and back.

Fast forward 33 years....

In 2016 I joined the Porsche Club of America, Alpine Region, for Rocky Mountain High Ways, five days of scenic mountain driving and canyon carving from the Hotel Elegante in Colorado Springs. Our leaders of the event had obtained permission for all of us to drive over the bridge and back. So, in our seal gray 996 C4S, purchased from fellow Carolinas Region member, I was happy to participate in this rare opportunity. In the photo notice how, wooden planks form the road surface.

Never again would I want to repeat my experience. The oak boards are very strong, albeit old, at 20' long x 12" wide x 4-6" thick. Other than the bridge above & the distant

Rockies, only air is "visible." Meanwhile, under the wheels an unnerving, clanking, all-consuming sound creates images of the car and hapless driver breaking through the timbers and plunging into the abyss to a messy & certain death. The leather interior would be horribly bloody, but smashed beyond repair, as would the whole car & its humans. I felt light-headed & my stomach was churning. Yuck! Never again.



Today there is a zip line across the top of canyon and a swing on the edge with 200' cables to hold the seats. It swings out and over the 846' drop. No way. I am not even close to that adventurous. Plus, I was already too sick.

Nearby is the Skyline Drive, overlooking Canon City. The road ascends into the sky with countless switchbacks, then follows the ridge line along an ever-narrower path until it is a little, one-lane road with nary 4' on either side. Beyond this 4' space, the drops are 800' straight down. With no guardrails, looking out from the driver's seat, only the air is visible. Do not even think of opening a door. Holy (insert explative here)! What have I got myself into today?!

Eventually, the road starts to switchback down to Canon City. Several cars stopped at the first available bathrooms.

Canon City's federal prison inmates constructed Skyline Drive during the 1930-40's. Today the prison is a maximum-security facility housing the 9/11 suicidal mastermind, the Unabomber, the shoe bomber, and others.....

Moral to my story: Be careful what you agree to do with your Porsche. Ask questions. When your PCA leader isn't perfectly clear what you should expect, you might be in for a very memorable experience to share with your fellow Porsche enthusiasts.
