Narrative:

Yorktown Police report the arrest of twenty-five year old Matthew Hernandez of Yorktown, New York, who is charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation in the 3rd Degree, an Unclassified Misdemeanor and uninspected motor vehicle, a traffic infraction.

On February 21, 2016 at about 8:00PM, Officer Campion was on routine patrol when he observed a 2013 grey Honda traveling east on Old Country Way allegedly displaying an expired inspection certificate. The vehicle was stopped and the driver was identified as Matthew Hernandez. A routine check on Hernandez's license revealed that his driver's license was allegedly suspended for failing to answer a summons out of Bronx County.

The defendant was processed at the scene. He was issued two summonses and released on his own recognizance and is due to appear in Yorktown Justice Court on March 24, 2016 at 6:00 pm.
