Narrative: Yorktown Police report the arrest of 38 year old Joseph A. Kearns of Mohegan Lake NY who is charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation Third Degree, an Unclassified Misdemeanor, and Expired Registration, a Traffic Violation.

According to police on May 15th 2016 at approximately 12:37pm a call was received from a motorist reporting a property damage auto accident located on Old Yorktown Rd. Officer Doerr was dispatched to the scene at which time an investigation was conducted which revealed that one of the operators involved in said accident, identified as Joseph A. Kearns, allegedly operated a 2008 Nissan North bound on Old Yorktown Rd., while his NYS Drivers license was suspended and the vehicles registration was expired.

Kearns was arrested at the scene and transported to police headquarters. Following processing, Kearns was issued traffic summons in reference to the aforementioned charges and then released on \$100.00 bail. Kearns is scheduled to answer said charges in Yorktown Court on June 16th 2016 at 6:00pm.
