**Narrative:**

Yorktown Police report the arrest of 29 year old Edward J. Snow of 41 Jennifer Ln. Mahopac, New York 10541, who is charged with Driving While Ability Impaired by Drugs 1<sup>st</sup> offense, an unclassified misdemeanor, Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance 7<sup>th</sup>, a class A misdemeanor, Speeding and Failing to use designated lane, both traffic infractions.

Police report on June 2, 2016 at approximately 11:30PM, Officer Rohr and Officer Noone were assigned to narcotics enforcement when they observed a grey 2001 Subaru being operated at a high rate of speed and failing to maintain a designated lane on East Main St. in Jefferson Valley. A vehicle and traffic stop was initiated and an investigation at the scene revealed that the operator of the vehicle, Edward J. Snow, was allegedly driving while ability impaired by drugs as well as being in possession of a quantity of heroin. The defendant was arrested at the scene and transported to police headquarters for processing.

At headquarters, Snow was processed on the above charges, issued summonses and released to a responsible party on \$100 cash bail and is scheduled to appear in Yorktown Justice Court on June 13, 2016 at 6:00PM.

**Narrative:**

Martin later contacted Police Headquarters and advised that he was going to voluntarily surrender himself in regards to the incident. A short time later he came into Police Headquarters and was placed under arrest.

Luke W. Martin was processed on the above charge and later released on his own recognizance. He is scheduled to appear in Yorktown Court on July 07, 2016 at 6:00pm.


