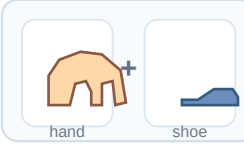
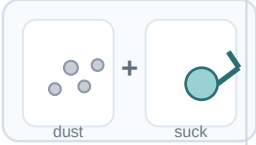
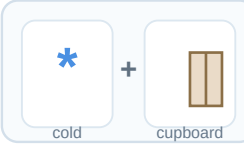
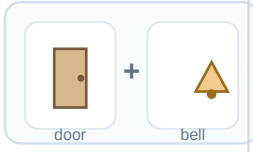


German Word Book - Balanced Sample

Memory tip: A very common daily word.		das Krankenhaus - hospital German: Krankenhaus English: hospital Break: Kranken + Haus Parts meaning: Kranken = sick people / ill Haus = house Example: Das Krankenhaus ist in der Stadt. English sentence: The hospital is in the city. Memory tip: Think: house for sick people.	
der Handschuh - glove German: Handschuh English: glove Break: Hand + Schuh Parts meaning: Hand = hand Schuh = shoe Example: Im Winter trage ich Handschuhe. English sentence: In winter I wear gloves. Memory tip: Funny memory: shoe for the hand.		der Staubsauger - vacuum cleaner German: Staubsauger English: vacuum cleaner Break: Staub + Sauger Parts meaning: Staub = dust Sauger = sucker Example: Der Staubsauger ist im Flur. English sentence: The vacuum cleaner is in the hallway. Memory tip: It literally sucks dust.	
der Kühlschrank - fridge German: Kühlschrank English: fridge Break: Kühl + Schrank Parts meaning: Kühl = cold Schrank = cupboard Example: Die Milch ist im Kühlschrank. English sentence: The milk is in the fridge. Memory tip: A cold cupboard.		die Waschmaschine - washing machine German: Waschmaschine English: washing machine Break: Wasch + Maschine Parts meaning: Wasch = wash Maschine = machine Example: Die Waschmaschine läuft heute. English sentence: The washing machine is running today. Memory tip: Easy memory: wash + machine.	

die Türklingel - doorbell German: Türklingel English: doorbell Break: Tür + Klingel Parts meaning: Tür = door Klingel = bell Example: Ich höre die Türklingel. English sentence: I hear the doorbell. Memory tip: Door + bell.		der Rucksack - backpack German: Rucksack English: backpack Break: Rück + Sack Parts meaning: Rück = back Sack = bag Example: Mein Rucksack ist schwer. English sentence: My backpack is heavy. Memory tip: Bag on the back.	
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Design note: this is the safer final direction - fewer cards than the ultra-compressed version, but all learning fields remain readable and neat.
