HOLISTIC HEALTH CARE FOR ALL – A DLF Foundation's Healthcare Initiative (2017-18)

"Aarogyam", a healthcare initiative of DLF Foundation is a 360 degree strategy where strong community outreach and community-based interventions have led to sensitization and prevention of diseases.

DLF Foundation's focus on providing holistic healthcare to all has led to the many successful initiatives with farreaching results during the year 2017-18. DLF Foundation has always prioritized healthcare for the residents of Gurugram and in line with this mission launched a Mobile Wellness Unit (MMU) based out of a Bus which has been remodelled to cater to medical examination and testing of Diabetes and Cancer (Cervical, Breast, and Prostate) to ensure early screening and detection of these diseases. Serviced by a team of senior doctors and pathologists, the Mobile Diagnostic Bus provides free screening for Diabetes and Cancer including HB1AC, PAP Smear, PSA and Lipid Profile testing to the large slum and village population of Gurugram.

Haryana Chief Minister Shri Manohar Lal Khattar flagged off DLF Foundation's first- of-its- kind Mobile Wellness Unit (MWU) in October 2017 in Gurugram. The Mobile Diagnostic Unit is equipped with all testing equipment for basic screening of Diabetes and Cancer including Digital Video Colposcope, an iBreast Exam machine, an automatic HB1AC Analyzer and a semi-automated Bio Chemistry Analyzer. Manned by a team of doctors, pathologist, nurses and lab technicians, it screened nearly 2600 beneficiaries between October ,2017 to March, 2018.

DLF Foundation has been in the forefront of providing "Mobile Medical services" in most Project locations across Haryana through the 7 DLF Mobile Medical Vans having on board both doctors and paramedics providing medical consultation and medicines which benefitted nearly 73,560 people of Haryana during the Financial Year 2017-18.

Committed to the mission of "Health for All", DLF Foundation in partnership with Medanta launched the 'Mission Stop Dengue' campaign for increasing awareness on the prevention, symptoms and cure of Dengue. The campaign was actively promoted using multiple platforms. The infomercial on the symptoms and cure of Dengue was telecast on NDTV 24x7 for nearly a month. Multiple workshops were organised in schools, villages and RWA's of Gurugram and initial testing and diagnostic services were provided through the MMU services.

DLF Foundation has been delivering healthcare in Gurugram through a team of doctors and paramedics managing the 10 DLF Primary Health Centres in urban and rural Gurugram which dispensed services to nearly 31,450 beneficiaries this year in addition to provision of healthcare facility in Delhi and Mohali through the Primary Health Centres which benefitted 9840 people. Through its "Aarogyam Project" DLF Foundation with support from Institute of Global Development (IGD) in 10 villages of Gurugram, has positively impacted lives of nearly 17,266 people in the past year.

In addition to the diagnostics, treatment and referral services, the healthcare program also focuses on preventive healthcare through awareness generation, advocacy and counseling services to children, adolescent girls and women. It also covers aspects related to sanitation and a green environment to ensure a healthy lifestyle for all .
