How to use your admission pass

Every pass has a unique code. A representative at the attraction will scan the code on each traveler's pass, granting you admission. For special offers at shops and restaurants, show your pass to your server or cashier.



Be aware of admission policies

Please read attraction information for hours, closings, and special admission instructions. Attractions with the **R** symbol require reservations. Attractions displaying **T** require you to pick up tickets at a separate location.



Pass expiration

Visiting your first attraction activates your pass. You have 30 calendar days to use your pass. You may visit each attraction once with the exception of shows at the V Theater; each show counts as one attraction. You have one year from the purchase date to use your pass.

1b. Big Bus DC Panoramic Night Tour

Getting in: Present your pass at the Big Bus kiosk at Union Station, 50 Massachusetts Avenue. The Big Bus representative will give you your Big Bus Panoramic Night Tour ticket.

1a. Hop-On Hop-Off Big Bus Washington DC: 1-Day Classic Patriot Tour

Getting in:

Present your pass at any Big Bus kiosk at Union Station, 50 Massachusetts Avenue. The Big Bus representative will give you your Big Bus ticket.

Ticket pick-up is available from 9:00 am-4:00 pm. Your Big Bus ticket starts at time of redemption. You will need to show only your Big Bus ticket to the driver when boarding a Big Bus. **Please note**, you may redeem your pass for a Big Bus ticket only once per life of card.

Open: Open Daily, 9:00 am-5:00 pm. See Big Bus DC website for extended seasonal hours.

Closed: Service may occasionally be disrupted due to severe weather, major city events, or festivals outside of the control of Smart Destinations or Big Bus.

Notes: The Patriot Tour includes the Red Big Bus loop. See the Big Bus website for a map of this route and nearby attractions. Multi-lingual recorded tours available; ask your bus driver. Factors such as traffic or weather can lengthen the amount of time between each stop so please plan accordingly.

3. Madame Tussauds DC

Getting in: Present your pass at the desk for admission.

Daily, 10:00 am-6:00 pm.

Seasonal hours subject to change. Madame Tussauds may be occasionally closed due to private events. Please consult [website](#) for updated hours and closures.

Notes: Children ages 4 and older must have a DC Pass or paid ticket for entry.

4. Newseum - 2 Day Admission

Getting in: Present your pass at admissions desk for admission. You will receive a 2-Day ticket.

Open: Daily, 9:00 am-5:00 pm

Closed: Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, New Year's Day and Inauguration Day.

Notes: DC Pass admission includes a second consecutive day for free! Children ages 6 and under are always free. July 1 through Labor Day, the Newseum waives admission for youth ages 18 and younger accompanied by an Adult or Senior admission.

5. International Spy Museum

Getting in: Present your pass at the front desk for a timed general admission ticket. Please note, lines may be long during busy season; make sure to arrive early!

Open:

Spring/Summer: / Daily, 9:00 am-7:00 pm

Fall/Winter: / Daily, 10:00 am-6:00 pm

Hours subject to change. Please check [website](#) for updated hours.

Closed: Closed Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

Notes: Self-guided tour. During peak touring seasons (such as Spring Break and major holidays), guests may experience a wait to enter the general exhibition. It is recommend that you visit early or late to avoid lines. Children ages 6 and under are admitted free.

6. George Washington's Mount Vernon

Getting in: Present your pass at the ticket window, where you will be given a ticket with a mansion tour time. Tour time is subject to availability based on the volume of visitation. The remainder of your visit is self-guided at your leisure.

Reserve Advance reservations are not available.

Open: April-October: Daily, 9:00 am-5:00 pm / November-March: Daily, 9:00 am-4:00 pm

Closed: Open 365 Days a year.

Notes: Admission includes a Mansion tour, and access to the grounds, Donald W. Reynolds Museum and Education Center, George Washington's Distillery & Gristmill (April - October) and other buildings. Programming and access vary by month and season. During peak times, Mansion tours may be abbreviated. Please see website for programming schedule and more details. Children ages 6 and older must have a DC Pass or paid ticket to Mount Vernon.

7 Washington Monuments Cruise by Potomac Riverboat Company

Getting in: Present your pass at the Potomac Riverboat Company ticketing cart, at the Georgetown dock located at The Washington Harbour OR at the Alexandria City Marina. In spring and fall, please go directly to the boat if the cart is not present.

Open: This is a seasonal cruise. Cruise times vary by month and day. Please check [website](#) for departures during your visit, especially on holidays.

Closed: November 1 - March 31, June 4, 2017 - 1:30pm/3:30pm Georgetown

Notes:

Your Pass is valid for select cruises only (see Hours for times.) Capacity is very limited and seating is subject to availability on a first-come, first-served basis only. Please arrive at least 30 minutes prior to departure time for your best chance to cruise. On holidays and summer weekends, please plan to arrive at least an hour prior to cruise time for your best opportunity to be ticketed.

8 Bike and Roll DC Bike Rentals

Getting in: Present your pass to Bike and Roll DC staff to set up your rental.

Open: Seasonal. Please call (202) 842-2453 for updated hours of operation.

Closed: Seasonal. Tours offered daily, March 14-December 6. Closed July 4th and November 26th.

Notes: Your Pass includes a 3-Hour Trek hybrid bike rental with small handlebar bag & rack, helmet, u-lock & city map. You can upgrade your 3 hour rental to a full day rental for \$16 per bike; please speak with a Bike and Roll DC team member for more details. A credit card is required, Bikes subject to availability. Kids bikes and trailer attachments are available for an additional fee.

Getting in: Present your pass at the ticket booth.

Memorial Day-Labor Day: 10:00 am-12:00 midnight / Winter Hours: Monday-Friday, 4:00 pm-10:00 pm; Saturday and Sunday, Noon-10:00 pm / Fall Hours: Sunday-Thursday, 11:00 am-10:00 pm; Friday and Saturday, 10:00 am-11:00 pm.

Hours are seasonal and subject to change.

Getting in: Present your pass at **1)** the Potomac Riverboat Company **ticketing booth in Alexandria** at the Alexandria City Marina OR at **2) National Harbor at the National Harbor Ticket Booth located in front of McCormick and Schmicks OR 3)** on the **Gaylord National Resort - Marriott's Pier** IF you are a GUEST.

14 Washington Nationals Ballpark Tour

Getting in:
Present your pass at the Nationals Box Office

Note: Tours embark from the Media and Suites entrance on South Capitol St. Monday through Friday on gamedays and non-gamedays. On Saturday and Sunday tours depart from Media and Suites entrance if it is a gameday and from Right Field Gate on 1st St. SE on non-gamedays.

The tour does require a lot of walking but is both wheelchair- and stroller- accessible. Please arrive 15 minutes before your tour time.
