

YOUNG JEAN LEE (*Playwright and Director*) is a writer, director and filmmaker who has been called "the most adventurous downtown playwright of her generation" by The New York Times and "one of the best experimental playwrights in America" by Time Out New York. She has written and directed 10 shows in New York with Young Jean Lee's Theater Company, and toured her work to over 30 cities around the world. Her plays have been published by Theatre Communications Group (Songs of the Dragons Flying to Heaven and Other Plays; The Shipment and Lear; and We're Gonna Die) and by Samuel French (Three Plays by Young Jean Lee). She is currently under commission from Lincoln Center Theater and the Oregon Shakespeare Festival, and has written a screenplay commission for Plan B/Paramount Pictures. Her first short film, Here Come the Girls, was presented at the Locarno International Film Festival, Sundance Film Festival and BAMcinemaFest. In 2013, she released her debut album, We're Gonna Die, with her band, Future Wife. Lee is the recipient of a Guggenheim Fellowship, two Obie Awards, a Prize in Literature from the American Academy of Arts and Letters, a Doris Duke Performing Artist Award, a Doris Duke Artist Residency, a Foundation for Contemporary Arts grant and the ZKB Patronage Prize of the Zürcher Theater Spektakel.

DAVID EVANS MORRIS (Scenic Design) makes original performance work and scenographic environments for the theatre. Previously with Ms. Lee: Untitled Feminist Show, Lear and The Shipment. He has also collaborated regularly with Target Margin, Taylor Mac, Clubbed Thumb (Affiliated Artist), Les Freres Corbusier (Associate Artist) and HERE, where he has twice been a Resident Artist. He was a co-creator (with Alex Timbers) and designer for Boozy: The Life, Death, And Subsequent Vilification Of Le Corbusier And, More Importantly, Robert Moses and (with Kristin Marting) the alt-rock opera Orpheus, which was included in the 2007 Prague Quadrennial. He has received a Princess Grace Fellowship, a Hewes Design Award nomination and holds degrees from the University of Washington Seattle and Williams College, where he is an Associate Professor of Theatre.

ENVER CHAKARTASH (Costume Design) is a company member of The Wooster Group where he designed costumes for Early Shaker Spirituals and Early Plays. In addition, Enver is a frequent collaborator with Tina Satter's Half Straddle, designing costumes for Seagull (Thinking of You), House of Dance and Ancient Lives.

CHRISTOPHER KUHL (Lighting Design) is a lighting, scenic and installation designer for new performance, theatre, dance and opera. Recent work includes Appropriate, The Object Lesson, The Nether, Eclipsed, The Author and The Elephant Room (Center Theatre Group); The Institute of Memory (Early Morning Opera, REDCAT, TBA Festival); and Dog Days (LA Opera). He has also had the pleasure of working and making art at the Fusebox Festival, On the Boards, Kennedy Center, St. Ann's Warehouse, Philly Live Arts, Arena Stage, MCA Chicago, The Chocolate Factory, The Kitchen, Jacob's Pillow, Beijing Music Festival, Kaai Belgium, MAC France, the Holland Festival and the Edinburgh Fringe. CHRIS GIARMO (Sound Design) also co-sound designed Young Jean Lee's Untitled Feminist Show, and is the resident composer and sound designer for N.Y.-based theatre company Half Straddle (Ancient Lives 2015, House Of Dance 2014, Ghost Rings upcoming 2016). Her work has been commissioned by Danspace Project, LMCC, ICA/Boston, The Kitchen, Walker Arts Center, Dance Theater Workshop, Wexner Center for the Arts and American Dance Festival and has been presented internationally at Theatre de Vanves, Theatre de Gennevilliers and the Croatian National Theatre in Zagreb. She has been awarded The MAP Fund Grant, a Guggenheim Fellowship, a Creative Capital Award and a

Foundation for Contemporary Art Individual Artist Award. She has been an Artist-in-Residence at The Performing Garage Presents, Baryshnikov Arts Center, Park Avenue Armory and was a choreographic fellow at MANCC. She is currently working on the second iteration of her *Thank You For Coming* series, *TYFC*: *Play* which will premiere at the Wexner Center for the Arts in September 2016.

MIKE FARRY (*Dramaturg*) grew up between Avon and St. Joseph, Minnesota, and now lives in New Haven, Connecticut. He has been the dramaturg for all of Young /Jean Lee's performance projects.

AARON ROSENBLUM (*Producing Director*) is an independent producer working across the disciplines of music, theatre, dance and film. MICHAEL RITCHIE (Artistic Director) is in his 11th season as Center Theatre Group's Artistic Director, and has led over 190 productions to the Ahmanson Theatre, Mark Taper Forum and Kirk Douglas Theatre stages including the premieres of six musicals that moved to Broadway – The Drowsy Chaperone, Curtains, 13, 9 to 5: The Musical, Bloody Bloody Andrew Jackson and Leap of Faith – and the Pulitzer Prize in Drama finalist Bengal Tiger at the Baghdad Zoo.

STEPHEN D. ROUNTREE (Managing Director) joined Center Theatre Group this year as its new Managing Director. He was previously the President and CEO of The Music Center (2002-2014) and concurrently the CEO of the Los Angeles Opera (2008-2012). He served the J. Paul Getty Trust for 22 years, starting in 1980 as Deputy Director of the Getty Museum, then Director of the Getty Center Building Program, and in 1998, the Executive Vice President and Chief Operating Officer for the Getty Trust.

DOUGLAS C. BAKER (Producing Director) is now in his 26th season at Center Theatre Group. He is an active member of the Broadway League, the Independent Presenters Network and is a proud member of the Association of Theatrical Press Agents and Managers. In May 2013 Doug received The Broadway League's prestigious Outstanding Achievement in Presenter Management Award.

DIANE RODRIGUEZ (Associate Artistic Director). For Center Theatre Group, Diane has commissioned, developed and/or produced the new work of over 75 artists, both playwrights and companies, including *Neva* and last season's *How To Be A Rock Critic.* She curated and produced with REDCAT, *RADAR LA, An International Theatre Festival* in 2011 and 2013. Diane is an off-Broadway Obie Award winner and current President of the TCG Board.

NAUSICA STERGIOU (General Manager, Mark Taper Forum and Kirk Douglas Theatre) has worked professionally supporting artists in theatres of all shapes, sizes and locales including many seasons at Center Theatre Group as General Manager and, previously, as Audience Development Director. She oversees main stage productions at the Taper and

Douglas, as well as new play commissions and developmental productions. MFA, Yale School of Drama, and Outward Bound trekker.

GORDON DAVIDSON (Founding Artistic Director) led the Taper throughout its first 38 seasons, guiding over 300 productions to its stage and winning countless awards for himself and the theatre — including the Tony Award for theatrical excellence, Margo Jones Award, The Governor's Award for the Arts and a Guggenheim fellowship. The Kentucky Cycle and Angels in America (Part One) won the Pulitzer in consecutive years and, in 1994, three of the four plays nominated for the Tony Award for Best Play were from the Taper (Angels in America won). In 1989 Gordon took over the Ahmanson and, in 2004, he produced the inaugural season in the Kirk Douglas Theatre.
