- **June 3** Fabric marbling: Create a colorful silk piece using paint and household tools.
- **June 17** Puppet making: Learn to craft puppets out of household items.
- **June 24** Kaleidoscope making: Make homemade kaleidoscopes, optical instruments that create a colorful, symmetrical pattern when rotated.

All workshops will be held from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. and are bilingual in English and Spanish. The workshops are suitable for ages 15 and up. Snacks and beverages will be provided.
