"For The Love Of (or, the roller derby play)" follows Joy and Michelle, long-term partners who find their lives turned upside down when Joy joins a roller derby team called the Brooklyn Scallywags. Joy becomes close with the star of the team, Lizzie Lightning, and must decide how much she's willing to sacrifice to follow

her heart.

Second Production: "Rotterdam" from Skylight Theatre Company

A bittersweet comedy about love and identity set in the Netherlands, "Rotterdam" begins on New Year's Eve when Alice finds the courage to come out to her parents. Before Alice hits send on her email, Fiona reveals that she has always identified as a man and now wants to live as one, sending their relationship into a

tailspin.

Third Production: "Native Son" from Antaeus Theatre Company
