This is a special report live and direct from the west bank of the Red Sea. I was just the eyewitness of an unexplainable, incredible event. Listen carefully, folks, you aren't going to believe this! At nightfall yesterday the water of the Red Sea separated down the middle and formed a HIGH wall of water on either side. Then almost a <u>million</u> people, men, women, children and all their animals walked between these walls of water, came out on this side and they weren't wet, not even their feet!

(A drenched Israelite comes running in)

Well, most of the people.

Israelite Did you see that??!!

Announcer Yes, what's going on? Were you one of the people who came across? How did that happen?

For 430 years my people, the Israelites, have been slaves in Egypt. The God of our fathers, Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, caused terrible plagues, a plague is an unusually large number of insects or animals infesting a place and causing damage to that place. With Egypt caught in these plagues, pharaoh

eventually let us go. We were finally on our way to a life of freedom. God was leading us and we were all amazed at what had happened. The Egyptians even gave us a lot of jewels and riches to bring with us.

(Pull jewels out of tunic)

Announcer Wow! They gave you all that stuff? Why would they do that?

Israelite

We had caused them enough grief. They were willing to do anything to get us out of there. Anyway, an angel of the Lord and a giant cloud appeared in front of us to lead us since we had no idea where we were going. When it got dark some of the people looked behind and noticed chariots in the distance. Of course panic rippled through all the Israelites. The Pharaoh and his army were coming after us. Some folks got downright nasty with Moses. They accused him of bringing them out in the wilderness to die. Can you imagine? After all God had done to get them out of Egypt, they couldn't believe He had a plan. But the situation got worse. As we looked ahead, we saw that the Lord was leading us to the Red Sea. How would we get away? The sea was too deep for us to cross and the Egyptians were behind us. I must admit it did look pretty hopeless. But Moses said to the people, "Do not fear! Announcer

Israelite
