We need to care more ... to support each other as we strive to run the race. We can't solve every desperate issue that we see in the distance, but we can reach out a hand to those amongst us that need help today.

The session included the bible story of the true vine as well as some singing, and then we all enjoyed a ploughman's tea, and grapes, together.

It was lovely to welcome 13 families [39 people were registered] to our first Messy Church and we look forward to the next one on the  $11^{th}$  October at 3pm.

In October we also have the Alamein Service, and for this year only, it will

include the Military Wives choir and so will be held at St Mary's Church in Andover. The date is Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> October and the afternoon will begin with refreshments and a display to look at from 2pm. Then the service will be held from 2.30pm till 3.30pm. There will follow a concert by the Military Wives choir from 4pm till 5.15pm. For more details please contact Liz Cosgrove.

We also have our Family Service to look forward to in October at the church in Smannell, where we will be taking the theme of light. This is a short, child-friendly service on Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> October, beginning at 10am, and ending by 10.40am with refreshments. All are welcome ... grans, grandads, aunties, uncles, parents, children, babies and those on their own. It should really be called an All-Age Service as it is for everyone! If you haven't been to one yet, do give it a try.

Our new house groups on Prayer will begin in October, on the last Monday of the month. On Monday 31<sup>st</sup> October from 2pm to 3.30pm, followed by refreshments, there will be an afternoon group at the Rectory. #### **Smannell Parish Council**

#### Little London Notice Board

The notice board is suffering from water damage. The council has agreed, following a request from the public, that the board be moved inside the bus shelter. The work will be carried out shortly.

#### Little London and Upper Enham Roads

Hampshire CC was requested to move the traffic signs on the entry to Little London for them to be easier for drivers to see, and for the 30 mph sign on approach from Frenches Farm to be moved further from the village.

The council was also requested to put in a small area of paving by the Green Lane bus stop for the use of passengers.

Hampshire CC was also asked to consider a 30 mph speed restriction through Upper Enham where the road is narrow and where there are driveways with limited visibility. Accidents have been reported on this section of road.

The Parish Council will hear back from Hampshire CC regarding these requests.

#### Augusta Park

Test Valley has been asked to increase their surveillance of vehicles parking on double yellow lines. Some parking tickets have been issued but have not, as yet, solved the problem.

The Parish Council is placing park benches and dog bins in Augusta Park. Test Valley are carrying out the procurement and installation on our behalf.

#### **NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH**

#### EMAIL SCAM

Action Fraud is warning that there is a phishing email currently in circulation that claims to be from the City of London Police. The departments that it claims to represent include the "Fraud Intelligence Unit" and the "National Fraud Intelligence Bureau". The email is titled "compensation fund" and has a letter attachment that claims to be offering financial compensation to victims of fraud. The letter uses the City of London Police logo.

The letter states that in order for compensation to be arranged, the receiver of the email should reply disclosing personal information. It states that HSBC and the South African Reserve Bank have been chosen to handle the compensation claims. All of these claims are false.

The email and letter are fraudulent and should not be replied to.

#### **Protect Yourself**

Opening attachments or clicking links within emails from unknown sources could result in your device being infected with malware or a virus.

The City of London Police and the National Fraud Intelligence Bureau will never email you asking you to disclose personal information.

If you believe you have become a victim of this fraudulent email get your device checked by a professional and make a report to Action Fraud, the UK's national fraud and cyber
