The man was born in London, England in 1889. His parents were stage actors. They sang songs and performed plays on the stage. He had a brother who was four years older than he. His father died and his mother became sick when he was little. His family was very poor and lived a hard life.  C  At the age of five, he stood on the stage for the first time \*instead of his mother. He found that entertainment could make audiences happy and also make him happy. At that time, he became interested in acting on the stage. He never forgot his dream to become an actor and he kept working hard with his brother to live. He never gave up his dream.

He was able to join a famous theater company when he was seventeen. There he improved his acting skills with only gestures called \*pantomime. He studied acting and made efforts to entertain audiences. The company which he belonged to held a U.S.A. tour, so he went there for the first time. A film director came to watch the show on the stage, and then his acting caught the attention of the director. The film director asked him to join the field of film. He started to work for the film company.

He wanted to make his own symbol, so he decided to act as a \*unique character in every film that he appeared in.  D  The character which he made is well-known worldwide. It is the man wearing a small black hat and jacket, big trousers, and big shoes with a walking stick. He has a small \*mustache. The character became his symbol.

At the age of twenty-five, he was able to \*debut in a silent film. Surprisingly, he acted in about fifty films for the first two years after he debuted in a film. He showed his pantomime and dance in films, and the audiences enjoyed them.  E  His brother started to support his career as his manager. Even after he was successful, he never changed his attitude to act and produce his own films. He became one of the greatest actors and film directors in the world.
