

The FEDORA Platform offers visibility for the shortlisted and nominated projects for the FEDORA Prizes. The online voting and donating activities contribute to the accessibility of opera and ballet by encouraging the general audience to discover and support their favourite projects.








Supporting artistic excellence and international collaboration


