# The Data Set: Speed Dating Experiment

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- Data was gathered from graduate and professional students at Columbia University from 2002-2004
- At the end of each date participants were asked:
  - If they wanted to see their date again
  - To rate their date and themselves on the same six attributes:
    - attractiveness, sincerity, intelligence, fun, ambition, and shared Interests
- Additional data was also gathered from a questionnaire asking for things like:
  - Basic demographic information
  - Beliefs on what others find valuable in a mate
  - Individual dating habits

# Can anybody find me somebody to love?

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What are the differences between people who prefer to date within their race and those who do not have a preference?

Is it possible to predict matches between two people using limited variables, including self-identified dating preferences?

# That Somebody's Profile...

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- Age:
  - between 21 and 30
- Ethnicity:
  - 48 % non-caucasian
  - 52 % caucasian
- Looking For:
  - a fun night out

# Is a person's preference for dating within or outside their race influenced by:

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- How they perceive themselves?
- What is important for them to have in a partner?
- Their race, age, gender, religious preference and goal for dating?

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# Find Me Somebody to Love...

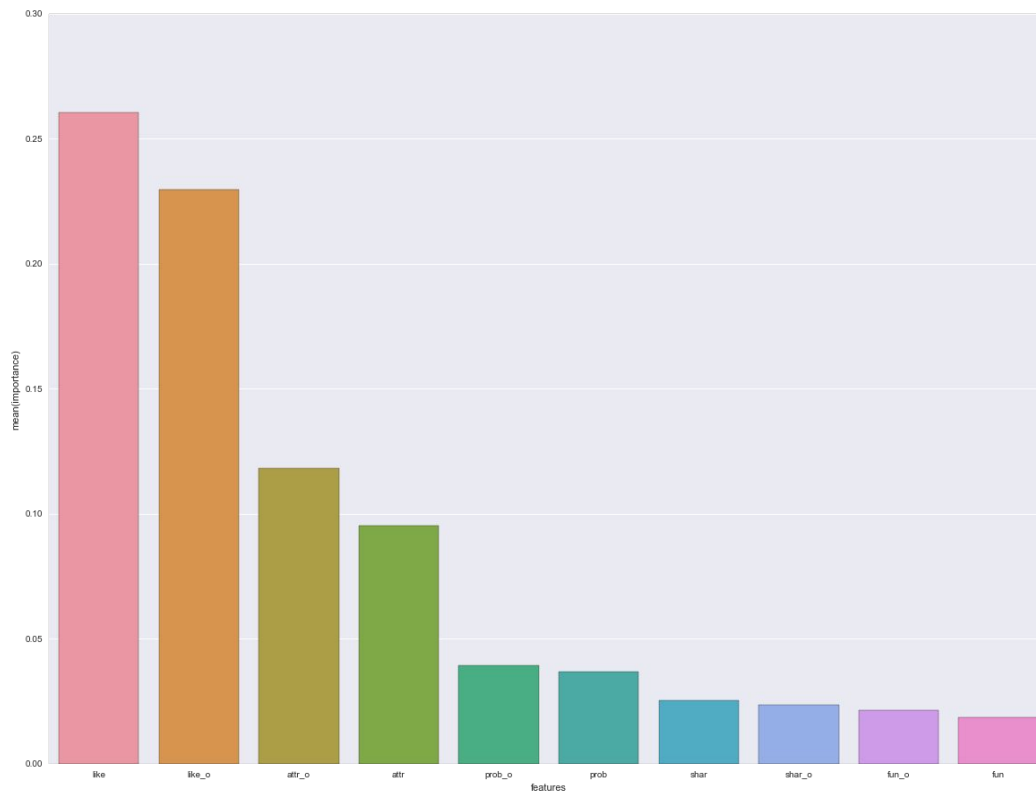
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Not a match:92%

## Strongest Predictors:

- How much two people like each other
- How physically attracted people are to each other
- The greater the probability someone thinks the other person will say yes to a date with them the more likely a match





# What does this tell us?

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It's difficult to predict a match.
