

Welcome to the 2024 SHTC Singles Box League

The purpose of the league is to encourage competitive play and an opportunity to meet new Members.

Players to be grouped together in boxes of similar NTRP level.

The plan is to run the 2024 Singles Box League from July to the end of the outdoor season.

Rules.

- SHTC Singles Box League is for SHTC Members only.
- Match format is a Pro Set - Winner is first to 8 games, win by 2 games
- (7) Seven Point Tiebreak at 7-7.
- Singles Box League matches **DO NOT** have court priority. Match must be completed within the normal Club court use allocation rules. If a minimum of 2 Members are waiting for your Court, you have a maximum of 30 minutes to complete the match.
- In the event that the match is unfinished due to limited time, it is at the discretion of the two Players concerned as to how to decide the match.
Suggestions:
 1. Wait until another court is available.
 2. Agree to play again at a future time to finish out the match.
 3. Stop the game and award the win to the Player in front e.g. someone is winning 6-2, give the two Players 2 extra games to bring the winning Player up to 8 games (8-4 win overall).
- Players are responsible for arranging their own matches and supplying their own balls.
- Only one match per opponent counts towards the Box League results.
- Submit scores online thru your GTN account.
- If Players are tied at the end of the round, the Head to Head match result will be the tiebreaker.
- Box League points to be awarded as follows. Points are given for playing games as well as for winning them, to encourage participation. Points are awarded as follows:-
 - 8/0 (winner gets 20, loser 4)

- 8/1 (winner gets 19, loser 5)
- 8/2 (winner gets 18, loser 6)
- 8/3 (winner gets 17, loser 7)
- 8/4 (winner gets 16, loser 8)
- 8/5 (winner gets 15, loser 9)
- 8/6 (winner gets 14, loser 10)
- 8/7 (winner gets 13, loser 11)
