LMHH Ladies Ladder League

WHAT IS A LADDER LEAGUE?

A ladder league is an organized league in which players with similar skills compete against each other in a competitive, structured format. Leagues can have various formats, ladies single, men's single, mixed single or any variation of teams.

System ranking for this league will be by % of wins/losses, weekly court assignments will also not be in rank order, every 4th player will be assigned to a court. For example, ranked players 1, 5, 9, 13, 17 would be on court 1... 2, 6, 10, 14, 18 would be on court 2...

Ladies Doubles - no partner (you play with everyone on your court)

Participants will be placed in groups of four, five or six (if necessary) each week in the order of their position (ranking) on the ladder each week. Ideally 5 people per court. (ex. Player 1 - 5 play on Court 1, Player 6 - 10 play on Court 2, etc.)

Five People

- All players will play four games to fifteen (15) in a round-robin format with the other four players in the group. One person will sit each round.
- First to 15

Four People

- All players will play three games to twenty-one (21) in a round-robin format with the other three players in the group. No one sits.
- First to 21

Six People

- All players will play six games to eleven (11) in a round-robin format with the other five players in the group. Two people sit per round.
- First to 11
- Once matches are complete, scores are entered into Global Pickleball Network for each of the games. Players may move up or down the ladder the following week, depending upon their performance in their round-robin games.
- The goal is to climb the ladder to the highest rung. Each participant will be responsible for recording and reporting their own scores after each match in Global Pickleball Network.
- A prize will be awarded for the top ranked individual(s)

Ideally there will be five people per court, but depending on the attendance each week, one court may have 4 or 6 people.

Global Pickleball Network – Sign in and click on leagues for registration dates.

- Sign into GPN to register for the appropriate league.
- There are two leagues for our club levels 6 weeks
 - Level 4&5 Wednesday's at 4pm starting 4/2/25
 - Level 2&3 Wednesday's at 6pm starting 4/2/25
- Every participant will have to sign up.

- Click the leagues tab on the left menu
- Click on the Ladies Spring Ladder League 2025
- Scroll to the league ladders
- Click the league for your level and register

Participation

- The leagues need a minimum of 20 players and a maximum of 24
- If the league fills up go ahead and register, you will be waitlisted
- Calander events will be added for each week
 - You must indicate your attendance. The lineups are established the day before and if attendance is incorrect, it will delay play.

Fees

- \$10.00 per player for the 6 weeks
 - Please bring your registration fee to the first day of play

Format

- You will play one game with each person assigned to your court as your partner
- See above for number of games played depending on attendance

Ranking

- The system will automatically rank each player. Updates happen at night
 - o The first week players will be randomly assigned to a court
 - Going forward every 4th player will be assigned to a court
 - You will be able to see everything in GPN

Missing Days

- You will not be penalized for missing a week, your rank will stay the same
 - Keep in mind depending on how the other players do you can still move up or down the ladder

Rain Outs

Because we are using courts during the evening club play, there will not be any make-up in the
