Campbell Lakes Preserve Policies



Fishing Regulations

- 1. A \$2 daily fishing fee is required for each person ages 16-59
- 2. Children 15 years and younger must be supervised by an adult.
- 3. An Ohio fishing license is not required.
- 4. Limit of two poles in use per person.
- 5. Bass and northern pike are catch-and-release only. Bluegill, crappie and yellow perch are limit of 10 each per day.
- 6. Snagging, spearing, seining and trapping of fish are prohibited.
- 7. Trotlines are prohibited.
- 8. Wading is prohibited.
- 9. Swimming is prohibited.
- 10. Ice fishing is prohibited.
- 11. Campfires are not permitted.
- 12. Users are required to carry out all litter.

Fishing Fee Payment Instructions

- 1. Complete collection envelope and permit.
- 2. Tear envelope at perforated edge.
- 3. Seal \$2 daily fishing fee in envelope.
- 4. Drop envelope in collection box and retain permit.
- 5. Permit must be kept on hand at all times.

All fees collected will be used by Great Parks of Hamilton County for fishery management of Campbell Lakes Preserve.

Boating Regulations

- 1. Boating is permitted at your own risk.
- 2. Only licensed car-top boats are permitted.
- 3. Trailers and motors of any kind are not permitted.
- 4. All Ohio Division of Watercraft Rules and Regulations must be adhered to at all times (ORC 1547).
- 5. One personal floatation device per person must be present on the watercraft at all times (ORC 1547.25).
- 6. Boats will not be permitted on the lake when there is ice present or when the lake level rises above its banks.
- 7. Boats will not be permitted on the lake during thunderstorms and other severe weather conditions.
- 8. Kayak rolling is prohibited.
