This logo is the primary graphic used for the Governor identity. Always use approved artwork. Do not under any circumstances attempt to match this letterform with other typefaces, no matter how similar they may appear. This will ensure the consistent use of the wordmark in all applications.



### I. LOGO STANDARDS

This logo is the primary graphic used for the Governor identity. When used make sure to give the Governor logo a proper amount of surrounding space. Always use approved artwork. Do not under any circumstances attempt to match this letterform with other typefaces, no matter how similar they may appear. This will ensure the consistent use of the wordmark in all applications.







Do not attempt to make the logo any smaller than .25" tall


Don't change typeface or use sentence case for wordmark






