

Revolver Chardonnay 2016

This 100% Chardonnay is from a high elevation vineyard in the Gualtallary region of the Uco valley. The nose shows white flowers, pear, apricot with lifted notes of nutmeg, mace, and a flinty mineral quality. The restrained palate shows honey suckle, pear, toasted almond paste, with light hints of whipped honey butter. Bright acid and with a hint of creamy oak shine through on this tiny production Chardonnay.

REVOLVER

Leo Erazo, the winemaker of Altos Las Hormigas, produces a small amount of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir from a parcel planted on limestone located in Gualtallary in the Uco Valley of Mendoza. The first vintage of Revolver was produced in 2013, and Leo has continued to produce these wines every year. Revolver is Burgundy inspired, and the wines are naturally fermented in neutral barrels and concrete eggs. We import very small amounts of these elegant bottlings, and try not to drink more than we sell.
