

Revolver Pinot Noir 2018

This 100% Pinot Noir comes from a single vineyard in the Paraje Altamira region in the Uco Valley. The nose bursts with crushed raspberries and rose petals surrounded by underlying notes of dusty cinnamon and clove. The palate shows subtle notes of raspberry dusted bacon with a little wild animal quality from being unfiltered and unfined. Bright acid on the finish lets the flavors linger.

REVOLVER

Leo Erazo, the winemaker of Altos Las Hormigas, produces a small amount of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir from a parcel planted on limestone located in Gualtallary in the Uco Valley of Mendoza. The first vintage of Revolver was produced in 2013, and Leo has continued to produce these wines every year. Revolver is Burgundy inspired, and the wines are naturally fermented in neutral barrels and concrete eggs. We import very small amounts of these elegant bottlings, and try not to drink more than we sell.
