### ITINERARY

**DAYS 1-2** : Arrival and transport to the village

**DAYS 3-4** : Mungere School and cultural exploration

**DAYS 5-7** : Lake Manyara National Park and  
Ngorongoro Crater Conservation Area

### ARRIVAL, TRANSPORT & THE MUNGERE SCHOOL

#### DAY 1 : Kilimanjaro Airport – Arusha

Private transport will greet you at Kilimanjaro International Airport (JRO) and transport you to your accommodation in Arusha for a good night's rest following travel. **Overnight: Arumeru River Lodge or similar (bed & breakfast)**

#### DAY 2 : Arusha – Mto wa Mbu

After breakfast, head west from Arusha and arrive at lodge accommodation in Mto wa Mbu town in the afternoon, viewing local attractions along the way, including an animal sanctuary and Maasai cultural museum. Receive cultural orientation from local Red Sweater Project staff members. **Overnight: Njake Jambo Lodge or similar (full board)**

#### DAYS 3-4 : Mto wa Mbu Town & The Mungere School

Enjoy an authentic East African experience in Mungere Village, a tribal community. Spend two days interacting with students, staff and community members at the Mungere School, a successful development education project. Work on a service project (optional), join in on a student football (soccer) match or basketball game, hike to nearby waterfalls on the Great Rift Valley escarpment, or teach in the classroom. Be sure to take time to enjoy the local life around you, taking in the sights, smells and sounds of village life. **Overnights: Njake Jambo Lodge or similar (full board)**

## SAFARI : LAKE MANYARA NATIONAL PARK & NGORONGORO CRATER CONSERVATION AREA (2 DAYS)

### DAY 5 : Mto wa Mbu – Lake Manyara National Park

Embark on your African safari adventure after breakfast by heading into Lake Manyara National Park. At the base of the Great Rift Valley escarpment, the scenery is as stunning as the exotic wildlife, including the park's famous tree-climb-ing lions. Plentiful herds of elephants, water buffalo, giraffe, zebra, and the mysterious leopard are found around this lake, covering 89 square miles. With over 10,000 in number, Tanzania boasts more bird species than any other country in Africa, including flamingos, pelicans, vultures, and various cranes.

**Dinner and overnight: Njake Jambo Lodge or similar (full board)**



### DAY 6 : Mto wa Mbu - Ngorongoro Crater Conservation Area

After breakfast, enjoy your final day of wildlife viewing by entering the Ngorongoro Crater, a geological marvel boasting several vegetation zones from lakes to forest to savannah. The Crater is home to approximately 30,000 animals, despite its tiny size of only 10 miles in diameter.

**Dinner and overnight: Njake Jambo Lodge or similar (full board)**

### DAY 7 : Mto wa Mbu – Kilimanjaro International Airport

After breakfast, embark on a self-guided hike or bike through the local banana fields. Spend time perusing your final souvenir purchases and saying goodbye to your new Tanzanian friends before your departure.

**Drive back to the Kilimanjaro Airport for evening departure.**
