

BANGKOK

The capital of Thailand, Bangkok is without doubt one of Asia's most colourful cities boasting an irresistible contrast of sacred temples, neon lights, bars, restaurants and some of the best shopping malls in the world. 


BANGKOK

The capital of Thailand, Bangkok is a hot, bustling city with everything going on. Rooftop bars overlooking busy streets sit happily next to sacred Buddhist temples that emanate calm, tranquillity and peace. Built upon water, the city once known as the 'Venice of the East' is now a bewitching place with an historic old town, gleaming modern shopping malls and lively nightlife.

CHIANG MAI

Bangkok's 'smaller, calmer little sister,' Chiang Mai in northern Thailand manages to combine its Buddhist traditions with a vibrant modern culture. It's an hour's domestic flight from the capital, and you don't have to venture far from the city to get far from civilisation. Visitors flock to the region for its authentic cultural experiences, wellness retreats and long-held traditions of arts and crafts.



BEST TIME TO VISIT

The dry season (Nov-Feb) is the best time for walking around Bangkok & Chiang Mai - it's a little bit cooler in Chiang Mai - and during the hot season (March-June) it can be quite warm and a little uncomfortable. The rainy season (July-October) is not as wet as you might expect. Rain is normally limited to short bursts and in Bangkok it can come as a welcome relief. In Chiang Mai, the rainy season is one of the favourite times of year, as showers keep the temperatures down, the countryside is green and lush and there are far fewer people around.

TOP THINGS TO DO

THE OLD TOWN

Immerse yourself in Thai history with a tour of Bangkok's old town which sparkles with must-see temples (wats) including Wat Pho with its reclining gold Buddha and the Royal Grand Palace with its rich architecture, ancient holy buildings and the Emerald Buddha, carved from a single piece of jade and the most revered object in Thailand.

NEW BANGKOK

The BTS Skytrain makes exploring Bangkok fast and easy - and it affords some fantastic city views. Head to Siam Square, the main shopping area, check out the colossal Central World shopping mall, visit the Museum of Counterfeit Goods (must be booked 24 hours in advance) and get an insight into Thai arts at the Bangkok Art and Cultural Centre.

RIVER KWAI & TIGER TEMPLE

Visit the forest temple of Wat Pa Luang Ta Bua Here, where Buddhist monks live in harmony with wild animals. History and movie buffs will love to see the Bridge on the River Kwai, made famous by the eponymous film, and the War Museum.

FLOATING MARKETS

Soak up Thai culture at Bangkok's Floating Markets, where an array of produce is sold from traditional canoes. The busiest is Damnoen Saduak in Ratchaburi Province, but there are many others well worth a visit.

CHIANG MAI NIGHT BAZAAR

Locals and tourists alike spill out on to the streets of Chiang Mai to enjoy its busy night bazaar, one of the city's main attractions and a mecca for designer goods, clothing, jewellery, DVD's and CD's at bargain prices.

PHUKET



Known as the 'Pearl of the Andaman,' Phuket is the largest of the islands off Thailand's southern coastline and a great base from which to explore the other islands nearby. It's extremely popular with tourists thanks to its beautiful sandy beaches, beach huts, cafés, restaurants and some of the best diving and snorkelling in the world. If you feel like a change from lying on a sun-drenched beach, there are plenty of diversions both on the coast and inland. Head to the Khoa Sok National Park for an unforgettable jungle experience, complete with elephants and lazy rivers.

BEST TIME TO VISIT PHUKET, KRABI & PHI PHI

The Andaman coastline has a tropical climate, which means it's warm all year round, but the periods of April-May and September-October are the hottest. The periods between November-March and June-August are generally considered the best times to visit. However, while the heavier rains in September-October can be a little disruptive, this part of Thailand enjoys a temperate zone and rarely has several consecutive days of heavy rain.



TOP THINGS TO DO

GO ELEPHANT HILL TREKKING

Experience the ultimate adventure trekking deep into the highlands on the back of an elephant and enjoy superb views over Chalong Bay.

VISIT PHI PHI BY SPEEDBOAT (Or see our add-on options opposite page)

It's worth taking a 45-minute cruise by luxury speedboat to Phi Phi Island. Explore the magical Maya Bay where the movie The Beach was filmed, enjoy snorkelling and sightseeing and relax with a leisurely lunch by the beach.

PHANG NGA HONG STARLIGHT CAVE TOUR

Paddle a canoe through hushed, naturally lit caves and beautiful blue lagoons, see a sunset like no other and enjoy stargazing and a sumptuous Thai buffet on the boat ride back to Phuket.

FANTASEA

This is a stunning 140-acre theme park packed with activities, carnivals, handicrafts, a 4,000-seat restaurant serving Thai fusion food, shops and theatrical extravaganzas.

BEST TIME TO VISIT

Weather in Koh Samui and Koh Phangan is almost always beautiful. Blue sky days and a pleasant ocean breeze are the norm. For the purists, the period between late December to the end of March provides the ideal tropical island weather experience, but then some like it hot and if that's you, April to June are sizzling! The months from October to early December see the heaviest rainfall, although it doesn't usually rain every day and often falls in short bursts.

TOP THINGS TO DO

ROUND ISLAND SIGHTSEEING TOUR

A boat tour is one of the most relaxing and pleasant ways to see the key attractions of these amazing islands.

BUDDHA STATUES

Standing majestically at the northern end of Samui, the modern Buddha, Wat Phra Yai, is one of the island's most famous landmarks. Nearby is the colourful temple of Wat Plai Laem featuring an enormous 18-armed Buddha.

FULL MOON PARTY (Or see our add-on options opposite page)

The famous Full Moon Party at Haad Rin beach on Koh Phangan draws large crowds every month. With music, fire dancers, jugglers and dancing, the party typically carries on all night until sunrise the following day.

ANGTHONG NATIONAL PARK

This unique park off the shores of Koh Samui consists of 42 stunning, untouched islands with tropical rainforests and deserted beaches. There are daily excursions with sightseeing, snorkelling, kayaking or walking included. The park is closed in November-December to allow for the natural rehabilitation of the environment.

FISHERMAN'S VILLAGE

Located in the tranquil resort of Bophut, Fisherman's Village boasts one of Koh Samui's finest beaches and has a charming, traffic-free 'walking street' lined with cafés, restaurants and shops selling local handicrafts.

BUTTERFLY GARDEN

Take your camera to this stunning garden with amazing coastal views.




