## **ORGANIC**

Organic wines are produced using methods that do not involve modern synthetic inputs such as synthetic pesticides and chemical fertilizers, do not contain genetically modified organisms, and are processed using a minimum amount of authorized additives. Low amounts of added sulfites are generally acceptable. Due to the various food standards agencies throughout the world, there are many different guidelines and regulations that determine whether a wine can bear an organic seal in a particular country.

## **BIODYNAMIC**

Biodynamic viticulture is a method of organic farming that originated out of the work of Rudolf Steiner in 1920's Europe. It considers the vines and the winery as a part of the larger environment, balancing the soil, plants and animals in a self-nourishing, living system. Methods unique to biodynamic farming (not found in organic viticulture) include the use of fermented herbal and mineral preparations as compost additives and the use of an astronomical sowing and planting calendar. Very few additives are used in the grape growing and winemaking. Very low amounts of added sulfites are generally acceptable. There are independent certification agencies for biodynamic products, most of which are members of Demeter International.

## **NATURAL**

There is no official definition or classification system for natural wines. Simply put, natural wine is just fermented grape juice. No added ingredients whatsoever. While you may not be able to taste the difference between an organic/biodynamic wine and its mass-produced equivalent, you most certainly will find natural wines to be unique in both nose and palate.

- NV**     **Huchu Homare, “Taiheikai”, Tokobetsu Junmai, Ibaraki-ken**     **8/55**  
Named for the Pacific Ocean, where this brewery lies. Light & fruity, with a little earthiness on the finish.
- NV**     **Saiya Shuzou, “Yuki No Boshu”, Yamahai Junmai, Akita-ken**     **55**  
Slightly gamey, with hints of roasted nuts and honey.
- NV**     **Sichi Hon Yari, Shizuku Junmai Daiginjo, Shiga-ken**     **125**  
This is a family-run brewery managed by the 15<sup>th</sup> generation. A special product made from free-run, or “drop” sake. Light and ethereal, with layers of freshness and complexity woven together.
- NV**     **Terada Honke, “Katori 90”, Junmai Muroka, Chiba-ken**     **48**  
Because only 10% of the hull was milled away, you’re essentially drinking liquid rice. Oily and luscious.
- 1999**     **Inoue Gomei, “Biden,” Junmai Yamahai Koshu, Fukuoka-ken**     **14/**  
Unique because of its age, this exhibits savory caramel flavors and is the **100**  
true definition of umami.
- 2002**     **Uehara Shuzo, “Taiko No Izanai”, Yamahai Muroka Nama**     **70**  
**Genshu Shinsosui-jikomi Shizenshu Koshu, Shiga-ken**  
With organic rice and no added yeast, this is a return to ultra-traditional brewing. There is a beautiful, enormous wood press and an equally regal wooden rice steamer. It was made with seawater, and needed more than 13 years before the salt softened.

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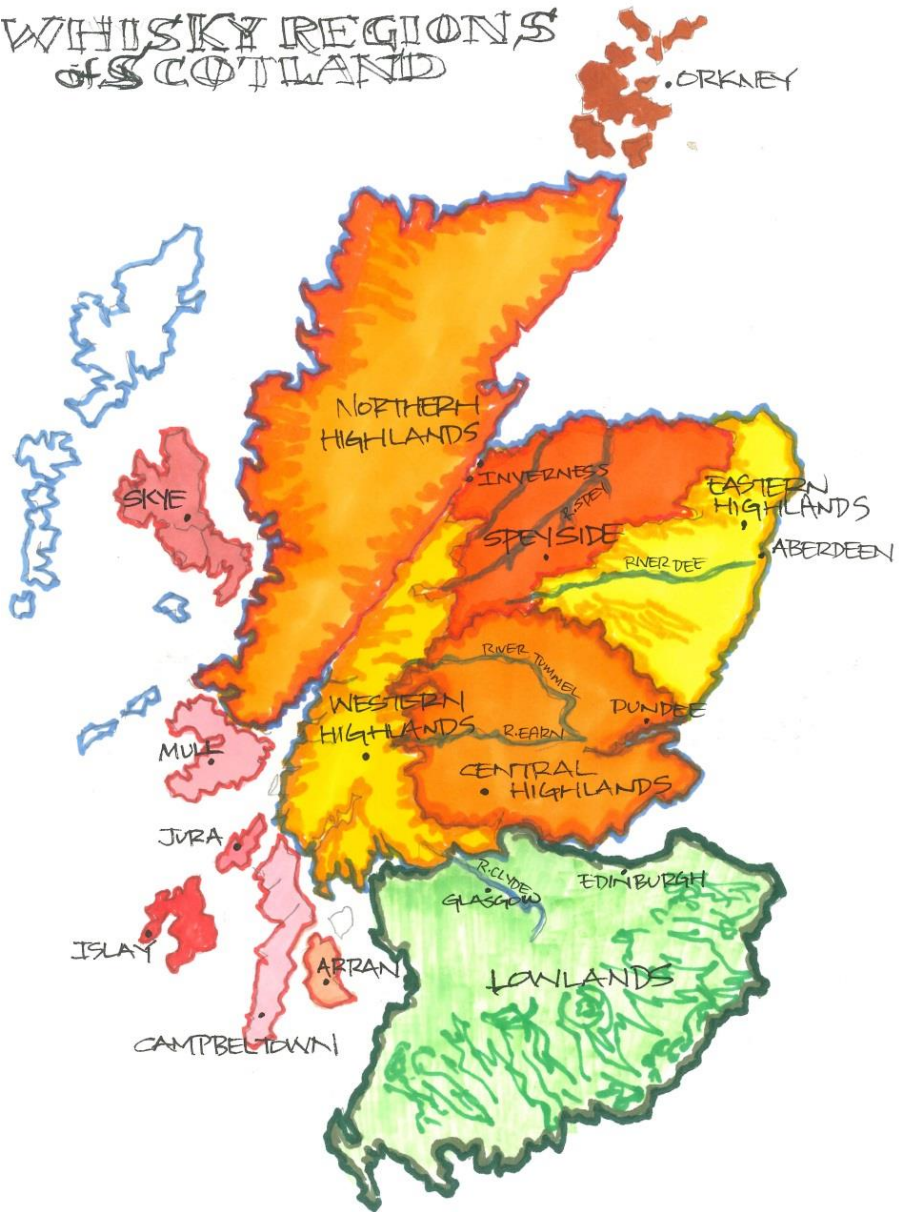
