# SAKE

**NV Saiya Shuzou, "Yuki No Boshu", Yamahai Junmai, Akita-ken 55**  
Slightly gamey, with hints of roasted nuts and honey.

**NV Shichi Hon Yari, Shizuku Junmai Daiginjo, Shiga-ken 125**  
This is a family-run brewery managed by the 15<sup>th</sup> generation. A special product made from free-run, or "drop" sake. Light and ethereal, with layers of freshness and complexity woven together.

**1999 Inoue Gomei, "Biden," Junmai Yamahai Koshu, Fukuoka-ken 14/**  
Unique because of its age, this exhibits savory caramel flavors and is the true definition of umami. ---

**NV Fukuchiyo Shuzo, "Nabeshima", Junmai Ginjo, Saga-ken 8 / 55**  
Named in honour of a prominent samurai clan that dominated the area through the Edo Period. A "slow & low" fermentation preserves freshness, but still allows for some opulence.

**2002 Uehara Shuzo, "Taiko No Izanai", Yamahai Muroka Nama 70**  
**Genshu Shinsosui-jikomi Shizenshu Koshu, Shiga-ken**  
With organic rice and no added yeast, this is a return to ultra-traditional brewing. There is a beautiful, enormous wood press and an equally regal wooden rice steamer. It was made with seawater, and needed more than 13 years before the salt softened.

- 2013 Pet'Nat, Chenin, Jauma / James Erskine, McLaren Vale, South Australia** 19  
Ex-sommelier turned pioneer winemaker, James is offering us the first Australian chenin pet'nat, sun-kissed and bold!
- N.V. Champagne, Lelarge-Pugeot, "Tradition", Brut 1er Cru, Petite Montagne de Reims (in half bottle)** 23  
9<sup>th</sup> generation growers specializing in meunier, the 'other' grape of Champagne: softer, creamy, floral.

## WHITE

- 2013 Melon de Bourgogne, Guy Bussière – Val de Saône, "l'Arpège", Burgundy, France** 13  
In a forgotten corner of Burgundy, old vines of melon are flourishing: dry, briny, oyster-perfect.
- 2011 Mtsvane, Niki Antadze, Kakheti Republic of Georgia** 15  
A window onto the wine of 7,000 years ago, aged in buried clay qvevri on the skins with no additives: savory, white tea, clove, cheese rind & gold fruit.
- 2011 Jacquère, Jean-Yves Péron, "La Petite Robe", Savoie, France** 17  
Ex-Allemand & Schueller's disciple, Jean-Yves is producing no sulfur razor-sharp, uncompromising wines on the slopes of the Alps.
- 2011 Palomino Fino, Equipo Navazos / Niepoort, Jerez de la Frontera, Spain** 18  
An experiment for sure, turning out to be a great wine: the sherry grape palomino, unfortified, aged a couple of months under flor.
- 2015 Garnatxa Blanca, Escoda-Sanahuja, "Brutal!!!", Conca de Barberà, Catalunya, Spain** 19  
A one-off dedicated to the renowned Barcelona natural wine bar, hazy, rich, with lots of freshness & for sure some life.
- 2008 Chardonnay, Bindi, "Composition", Macedon Ranges, Victoria, Australia** 29  
Michael Dhillon, after his father, put this part of the world on the map for superb, layered and tense chardonnays. A must try!

Son of a natural wine hero, Baptiste is pursuing the search for highly quaffable, true-to-its-origin wine with this wild gamay.

Gulpable, mineral, refined expression of Bordeaux ready to drink young, from a committed pair of brothers in Barsac.

Deirdre is this amazing vigneronne, showing the impossible is possible like making Marquette Beaujolais-Nouveau style!

Cristiano works organically in the southern part of Italy, fermenting in amphora this cousin of zinfandel, full of mulberry & musk.
- 2015 Pinot Noir, Beckham Estate Vineyard, “Estate Pinot Noir”, Chehalem Mountains, Oregon 20**  
Starting as an art studio for Andrew’s ceramics, Beckham is becoming a new reference for beautiful, transparent Oregon pinots

Own-rooted vines struggling on the high-elevation granite of gold rush country: broad-shouldered, powerful, & earthy.

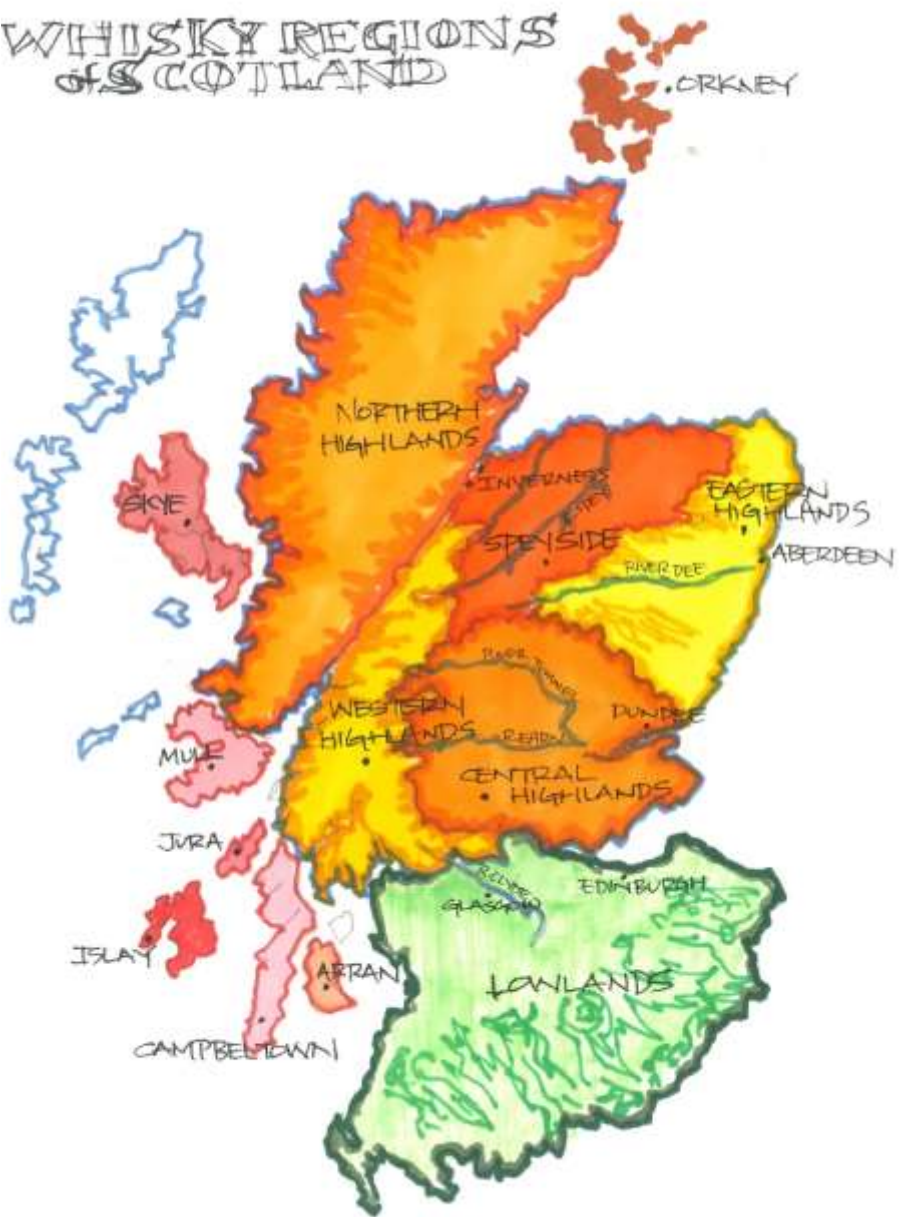
