

# “A decadently tranquil world...”

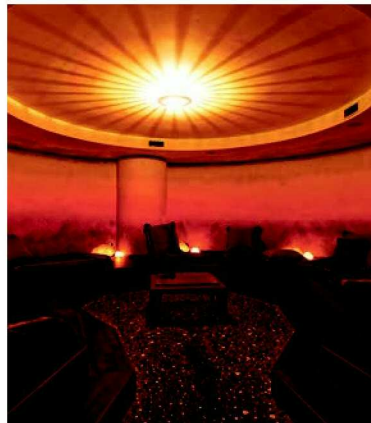

There’s also a vibrant Moroccan-style grotto with incense, filled with colourful floor pillows and partitioned by netted curtains; plus exclusive access to a sensual, sunken Salt Lake.
