



Spacers come in a vast array of sizes, so you can piece them together in various ways to create bead-like shapes, as with these earrings or the bracelet on page 60.

# Shadows Earrings

Finished length: 1½" (4cm)

## MATERIALS

- Twelve 3mm bright silver daisy spacers
- Four 4mm bright silver daisy spacers
- Four 5mm bright silver daisy spacers
- Four 5.5mm silver daisy spacers
- Four 6mm silver daisy spacers
- Six 7mm silver daisy spacers
- 2 silver ball head pins
- 2 interchangeable silver earring wires

## TOOLS

- Chain-nose pliers
- Round-nose pliers
- Flush cutters

**1. String the daisy spacers.** String three 3mm, one 4mm, and one 5mm bright silver daisy spacer onto a head pin. Then string on one 5.5mm, one 6mm, and three 7mm silver spacers. The second 7mm spacer is the center point of the earring.

**2. Complete the stringing pattern.** String the second half of the earring in reverse to match the first half.

**3. Complete the earring.** Make sure all the spacers are pushed firmly together. Then, create a wrapped loop (see page 10) after the last daisy spacer. Slip the loop onto the earring wire and gently close the hook.

**4. Make the second earring.** Repeat Steps 1–3 to make a second matching earring.
