

Directions from Malaga Airport - Route One

If you get stuck, please call us on: 952180778, or mobile: Di 696081354

Leaving the airport, follow signs to Cadiz/Algeciras.
Then E15 (toll).

Continue to exit number 172 (exit numbers are the same as the kilometer markers at the side of the road) onto A397/376 (either number) to Ronda (not much warning of this exit which is just after a tunnel).

From the airport to the Ronda turnoff is about 30 - 45 minutes. From the Ronda exit to the village is about 30-45 minutes.

After going through the toll gate, turn right and onto a roundabout. Follow the signs carefully to Ronda - you go almost 360 around it to get to Ronda turnoff.

Between Kilometers 11/12 at top of the mountain and immediately after a service/gas station, turn left following signs to Ruta del Legado de Fray Leopoldo and signs to Parauta, Cartajima, Juzcar. On the right hand side are wine and leather shops.

After one kilometer you will come to the left turning to the first village, Parauta. Ignore that and continue 5 Km to Cartajima. Turn left into village. Just after recycling bins on right, road forks. Don't go to the left down but bear right as you see in the photograph that follows. Then take the first hard right and park near phone box. Ignoring steps, walk up alley past phone box.

Approach from San Pedro and the Costa del Sol.
Turn left after the service/gas station as indicated by arrows.
On the right are wine and leather shops.
May be signposted to Parauta, Cartajima, Juzcar.
Cartajima is 6 km from this point.

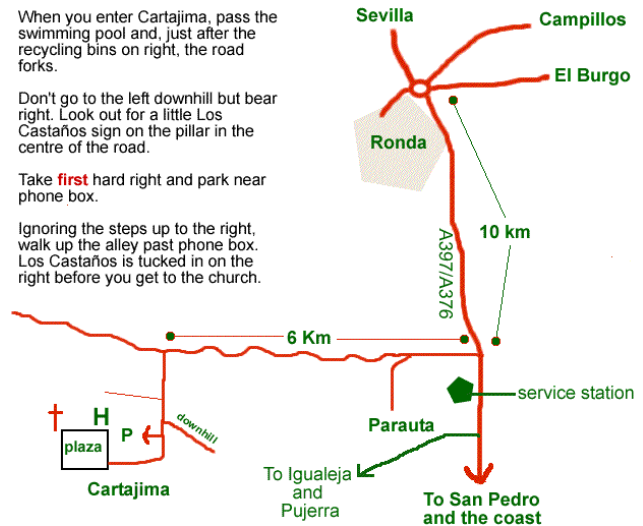


When you enter Cartajima, pass the swimming pool and, just after the recycling bins on right, the road forks.

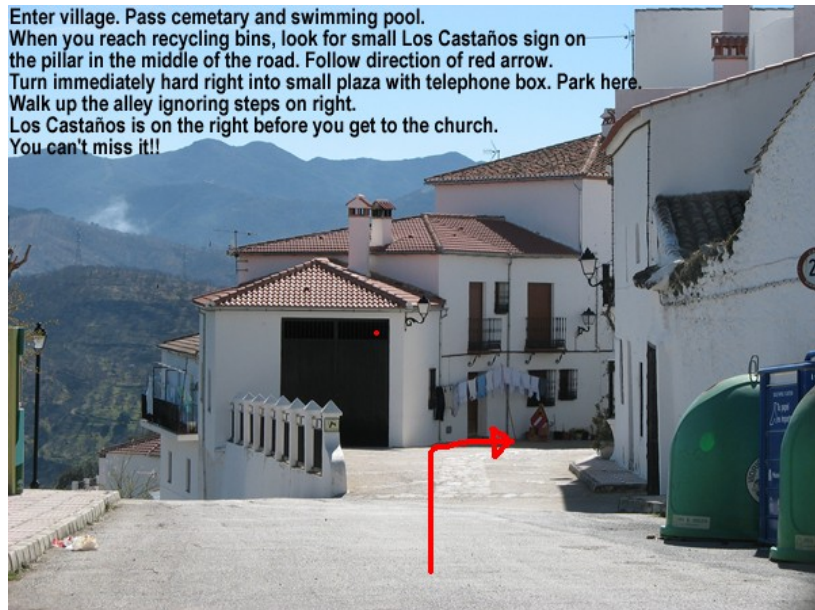
Don't go to the left downhill but bear right. Look out for a little Los Castaños sign on the pillar in the centre of the road.

Take **first** hard right and park near phone box.

Ignoring the steps up to the right, walk up the alley past phone box. Los Castaños is tucked in on the right before you get to the church.



Enter village. Pass cemetery and swimming pool.
When you reach recycling bins, look for small Los Castaños sign on the pillar in the middle of the road. Follow direction of red arrow.
Turn immediately hard right into small plaza with telephone box. Park here.
Walk up the alley ignoring steps on right.
Los Castaños is on the right before you get to the church.
You can't miss it!!



Update: the small Los Castanos sign referred to no longer exists.
