

#### **TRAVEL WISELY**

#### **U.S. Citizens**

A valid U.S. passport is required for all U.S. citizens regardless of age when traveling between the United States and the islands of the South Pacific. Passports must be valid for at least six months after leaving Tahiti, Fiji and the Cook Islands.

Any person younger than 18 is considered a minor. Minors traveling with only one parent must have a notarized written permission statement from the other parent. In the case of deceased or divorced parents, legal proof of custody must be carried to accept just one signature on the letter. Minors traveling unaccompanied or with anyone other than their legal parents or guardians must obtain an original notarized letter of permission signed by both parents. Airlines will also require the name, address and phone number of the person meeting the unaccompanied minor upon arrival.

#### Non-U.S. Citizens

Citizens of all other countries may need a visa in addition to a valid passport and should consult the nearest French Consulate or French Embassy, Tourism Fiji or the Cook Islands Tourism Corporation as early as possible.

#### Airport Check-In

Arrive at the airport at least two hours prior to departure to ensure a smooth check-in process. Airline counters generally open three hours prior to departure. Please have your passport and airline tickets with you for check-in.

#### **Before Your Trip**

As an international traveler, you should know the rules regarding items brought back to the United States. Before you leave, visit the U.S. Customs and Border Protection website at www.help.cbp.gov for details.

#### Currency

The official currency of Tahiti is the Pacific Franc. In Fiji it's the Fijian dollar and in the Cook Islands it's the New Zealand dollar. You will need to exchange your U.S. dollars for local currency or use a credit card for purchases.

#### **Electricity**

The standard electrical service in Tahiti is 220 volts; Fiji and the Cook Islands are 240 volts. It is recommended that you bring your own adapter and converter. Some hotels have dual voltage plugs.

#### **Checking Into Your Hotel**

Your accommodations are pre-paid. Please show your itinerary and hotel voucher to the front desk. You will be asked to provide a credit card or cash deposit to cover any personal charges.
