VOLUNTEER BENEFITS & POINTS GUIDE

Reward Schedule

- 25% off a SARR Race or Training Program 10 points
- 50% off a SARR Race or Training Program 20 points
- Free SARR Race or Training Program 40 points

Training Team volunteer benefits

- · Participate for free in the training program that you volunteer for
- Free Training Team Shirt
- End-of-year SARR Volunteer Appreciation event
- Earn points towards reduced race or training registration (requires 75% attendance at training)
 - o Head Coach earn 40 points per season
 - Assistant Coach, Pace Leader/Mentor, Signs & Water Team earn 20 points per season
 - Registration Coordinator, Equipment Coordinator, Social Committee, Speaker Liaison, Shirts
 Coordinator, other volunteer roles earn 10 points per season

Race volunteer benefits

- Participate for free in the Race After-Party
- Free Race Shirt (when available)
- End-of-year SARR Volunteer Appreciation event
- Earn points towards reduced race or training registration (requires completing volunteer task)
 - o Race Director earn 40 points per race
 - Assistant Race Director earn 20 points per race
 - Packet Pickup, Water Stop, Food Prep / Distribution, Course Marshall, Course Setup / Tear
 Down, Finish Line, Photographer, other volunteer roles earn 2.5 points per task

Club and Community Outreach volunteer benefits

- End-of-year SARR Volunteer Appreciation event
- Earn points towards reduced race or training registration
 - SARR Board Member, Director of Training, Director of Coaches, Webmaster, Training Volunteer Coordinator, Race Volunteer Coordinator, Zoo Run Lead, Meetup Lead, Monthly Fun Run Lead, Facebook page administrator – contact Vol Coordinator for detail on points earned per month
 - Community Outreach earn 2.5 points per event
 - o Adopt a Trail earn 2.5 points per event

FAQs

- How do I earn points? sign-up to volunteer, sign-in when you volunteer, complete your volunteer job!
 A SARR volunteer coordinator will reward the points you earned within 2 weeks of a race, event,
 training season end, or month end. Points are managed and maintained by the volunteer coordinator
- How many points will I earn? see the above points guide by volunteer role. Remember, points will be
 rewarded based on volunteer attendance and completing your volunteer job
- How many points do I have? email the Vol Coordinator to find out how many points you have earned
- How do I use my points to register for a SARR race or training program?
 - o identify a SARR race or training program that you would like to register for
 - email <u>volunteer@saroadrunners.com</u> indicating that you would like to use points to register
 - o the Volunteer Coordinator will email you back a one-time use percent-off discount code
 - o NOTE request for a coupon code needs to be made at least 2 weeks before registration closes
- Will I still receive the race discount associated with being a SARR member? Yes!
- **Do points expire?** points can carry over from year to year but will expire after 2 years of non-activity
- Can I combine volunteer coupon codes with other coupon codes? No
- Can I gift my points to someone else? No
- I already paid for registration are discounts retroactive? No
- I have some points, but not quite enough for the next level of % discount. Can I prorate my points?
 No, but we will let you know of upcoming volunteer opportunities!
- Can I volunteer early on race day and use points same day? No, points are for a future race or training
- How do I use the old volunteer cards? we retired the system of using paper volunteer cards Dec 2017.
 Older volunteer cards earned in 2017 will be honored through their expiration date
