




Ruffin it in Roanoke

WHAT BETTER WAY TO SEE ROANOKE, Virginia than with man's best friend? Started by Sponsor Hounds, the Woofstock Dog Festival is held each year in June at Elmwood Park where several shelter groups gather with an assortment of canines who are looking for their new forever homes. It's a fun atmosphere with music, food and contests

With Fido, walk along the Roanoke River on one of Roanoke's Valleys Greenways. Meander through parks and step back in time with a visit to historic Grandin Village. Although not exactly like the fictional small community of Mayberry from the Andy Griffith show, nostalgia is nevertheless around every corner. Don't leave town without a yummy cupcake from Viva la Cupcake and ice cream from Pop's Ice Cream & Soda Bar.

A visit to Black Dog Salvage is next on the list. Black Dog Salvage was created in 1999 by Mike Whiteside and Robert Kulp. They specialize in the reclamation, repurposing and resale of architectural, commercial, and industrial elements and fixtures from Virginia's architectural past.

Black dog Molly was the inspiration for Black Dog Salvage and lived a full life of thirteen and a half

years. Before she passed over to Rainbow Bridge, she was in charge of training their newest salvager, Sally the Salvage Dog. Sally is always eager to assist customers and their dogs while they explore 40,000 square feet of treasures.

Is Fido ready to see the world's largest man-made star? Head on out to the top of Mill Mountain and gaze upon this enormous creation. Constructed in 1949, it originally was to be lit only during the holidays. It now shines brightly each night up until midnight. While there, sightseeing opportunities include the Mill Mountain Zoo, one of the state's three accredited zoos and one of the few in the na-


tion located on a mountain as well as walking on the Mill Mountain trails.

Sally the Salvage Dog at Black Dog Salvage greets both human and canines alike. Black Dog Salvage was created in 1999 to provide a home for Southwestern Virginia's architectural past. The brainchild of entrepreneurs Mike Whiteside and Robert Kulp and inspired by Molly, Black Dog's namesake, the company found its beginnings with the salvage of some of Roanoke Virginia's most notable architectural details at 21 Highland Ave. Since that time, Black Dog has become the temporary resting place for architectural antiques, commercial salvage, and modern society's other cast offs.
