

## Washington Society of Association Executives [WSAE] to Meet in Tacoma: 2014

City will showcase hotels, meeting facilities and attractions

**Aug. 30, 2012—Tacoma, Wash.**—Tacoma's tourism industry will have the opportunity to show what makes the city a prime destination for meetings and events during a four-day conference of association executives from across the state. The Washington Society of Association Executives [WSAE] Annual Convention will meet in Tacoma May 31-June 3, 2014.

With 200 conference attendees, the city and its residents will receive nearly \$20,000 in economic impact from WSAE. The conference will present Tacoma to leaders that select locations in Washington state for their own association's meetings and events. "Once they see all that our city has to offer they'll be more likely to return," said Shauna Stewart, Tacoma Regional Convention + Visitor Bureau [TRCVB] Vice President of Sales + Marketing. And that means bringing back future business to boost the local economy.

TRCVB worked with community partners to book the conference earlier this month. The conference will take place at the Greater Tacoma Convention + Trade Center and Hotel Murano.

"We're excited about going to Tacoma in 2014," said Patty Anderson, WSAE Executive Director. "Each city has its own attributes, and Tacoma will surely be a huge success with our members."

Attendees can come a few days prior to the conference or stay after to explore Tacoma's culture. TRCVB is developing optional itineraries for attendees during the conference at nearby attractions. This will help make the attendee's stay memorable. And this will bring visitors to local businesses' doorsteps.

TRCVB makes significant contributions to Pierce County's economy. Last year TRCVB secured business equating to 41,052 meeting attendees with an estimated economic impact of more than \$6.6 million. In 2010 TRCVB secured business equating to 35,661 meeting attendees with an estimated economic impact of more than \$6.2 million.
