Greater Lansing CVB Recognized by Central Michigan Public Relations Society of America

LANSING, Mich.—The Greater Lansing Convention and Visitors Bureau received two awards from the Public Relations Society of America – Central Michigan Chapter, at the Annual PACE Awards on Wednesday, April 13, 2011.

The GLCVB won a Pinnacle Award, a top honor in the PACE Awards competition, in the category of Tactics: Electronic Media for the Greater Lansing Mobile App Campaign. The Greater Lansing Mobile App is a free download to web-enabled smartphones that provides up-to-the-minute access to area information.

The Bureau sponsored event, Over the Edge, brought in the Award of Excellence in the category of Special Events. Over the Edge is a fundraiser for the Team Lansing Foundation, the charitable division of the GLCVB, focused on regional destination development.

Tracy Padot, PRSA member and the Bureau's Vice President of Marketing Communications, attended the event, held at the Radisson Hotel Lansing at the Capitol, and accepted the awards on the Bureau's behalf.
